**F**rom the Pastor's Desk  
 This Sunday is the Feast of All Saints in which we celebrate the many canonized saints of the church, like St. Colman, St. John Paul II, and so on, but we also celebrate that countless host of holy people who have gone before us and now are in Heaven. We are also reminded to turn to them for their prayers just as we turn to each other on this earth for prayers. Monday is All Souls Day when we honor and pray for our beloved deceased. We are reminded that purgatory is the last great mercy. Scripture tells us that nothing imperfect may enter Heaven. Praise God for this place in which a soul which dies in a state of grace but not in perfection is passively purified of its remaining faults and prepared then to be perfect in Heaven. All Souls Day Mass will be at 7:00 p.m.

**Percentage Giving** – decide to give a percentage of income rather than a dollar amount

**Progressive Giving** – strive to increase that percentage over the years
