## From the Pastor's Desk

**F**rom the Pastor's Desk  
 In the calendar of the Church, St. Cecilia is commemorated on November 22 (but as it falls on a Sunday this year it is not celebrated). I bring this up because St. Cecilia is the patroness of musicians, so this is always a good time to say thank you to all who help enhance our liturgies by sharing their talents: musical, vocal, and planning and organization.

We at St. Colman's are very blessed in this. Our choir director and organist, our choir and cantors, all are very gifted and share their gifts for the glory of God. They put in a lot of time and work to help ensure our liturgies are properly and beautifully celebrated. The next time you see one of them, thank them for adding to the beauty of our liturgies and helping us to glorify God by their hard work and sharing of their talents.

There was a considerable amount of interest in Adoration during the stewardship renewal so I'm happy to say that we will be able to begin it soon. The first Tuesday night of Adoration will be on the first Tuesday of Advent, December 1. It will begin after the 5:30 Mass and continue until 8:15 p.m. Adoration will follow the RCIA schedule – so whenever RCIA is not meeting there will be no Adoration, whenever it is, there will be Adoration. If you signed up you will soon be receiving some information about how you can help ensure that those hours are always covered. If you did not sign up, you can still stop in for Adoration on those evenings. We thank those who are making a commitment so that we can ensure it is offered. Adoration is a wonderful way to connect with the Lord in sacred silence and before his Living Presence in the Eucharist.

Finally, a reminder that we will be having a Mass at 9:00 a.m. on Thanksgiving Day this week. The Mass is the perfect way to say "thanks" to God!
