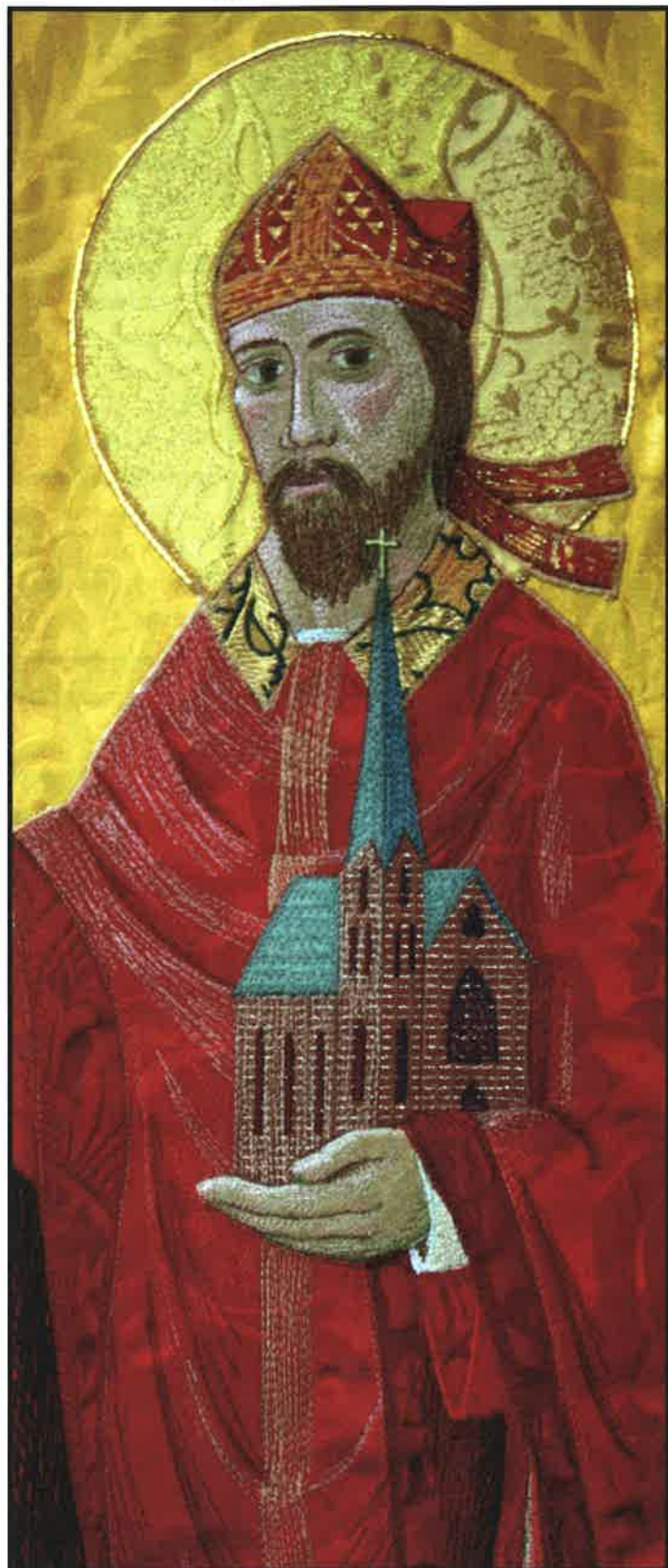

From the Pastor's Desk

Next week is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. Since there is so much to say about Holy Week, I thought I would run this reminder of the events of Holy Week in two columns, this week and next. The beginning of Holy Week is marked by the blessing of palms at Palm Sunday Mass (also known as Passion Sunday). The Church requests a solemn procession at one of the Masses. This will occur at the 8:30 a.m. Mass. We will meet at the Parish Hall, have the blessing of the palms, and then process to the church. In this we commemorate the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem, as we wave our palms and sing in triumph.

The first big event after Palm Sunday is the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral. This is concelebrated by the Bishop and many priests of the diocese. At this Mass the holy oils are blessed for the year, and then are brought back to each parish of the diocese. The Mass begins at 6:00 p.m. at St. Joseph Cathedral.

The Triduum (Latin meaning: "The Sacred Three Days") – Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil is the great culmination of the liturgical year.

On the first day of the Triduum, **Holy Thursday, Mass will begin here at 7:00 p.m.** In this Mass we commemorate the institution of the priesthood, the Eucharist, and a love that is stronger than death. In the past the foot washing ceremony during the Holy Thursday was meant to display both the institution of the priesthood and the universal charity of Christ. This is why the church's guidelines asked that twelve men be chosen to represent the twelve Apostles. This year, the Holy Father, Pope Francis, has changed the ritual to reflect exclusively the charity of Christ and not to represent the institution of the priesthood. Therefore, he has asked that in addition to explaining this change to the faithful, that pastors who choose to do this optional rite would choose a few of the faithful to represent the diversity of the Christian community (old, young, sick, male, female, etc.) Therefore, we will have six or so persons representing all of the faithful.

The Holy Thursday Mass concludes with a solemn procession of the Eucharist from the Church to a "Chapel". [from the Church's directives on celebrating the Triduum: "For the reservation of the Blessed Sacrament, a place should be prepared and adorned in such a way as to be conducive to prayer and meditation; that sobriety appropriate to the liturgy of these days is enjoined, to the avoidance or suppression of all abuses.

When the tabernacle is in a chapel separated from the central part of the church, it is appropriate to prepare the place of repose and adoration there." (#49)] This will be in the "library" of the Parish Center. So, weather permitting, a procession will take place from the church to the Parish Center Library. Here we will have the chance to continue in Adoration, "watching with Him" in his time in the Garden of Gethsemane.

In the year 2000, Father Mitchell Pacwa, S.J. established *Ignatius Productions*, a Catholic media production apostolate, under the Society of Jesus, whose mission is to teach people the scriptures, educate Catholics about their faith, and promote unity and understanding within the Mystical Body of Christ.

Father Pacwa received his B.A. in Philosophy and Theology from the University of Detroit, *summa cum laude*. He was ordained a Catholic priest in 1976 with the Society of Jesus and then continued his studies and then received his Master of Divinity and S.T.B. from the Jesuit School of Theology of Loyola University, *magna cum laude*. At Vanderbilt University, he received his Master of Arts as well as his Ph.D. in Old Testament.

He has taught at the high school, university, and seminary levels. He has lectured at hundreds of conferences and churches around the world. He is best known for his appearances on the *Eternal Word Television Network* (EWTN), where he currently hosts two programs – "Threshold of Hope" and "EWTN LIVE." Father Pacwa also serves as the weekly host of EWTN Radio "COFFEE & LIME" program.

Father Pacwa is fluent in twelve languages and has a unique understanding of the peoples and cultures of the Middle East. Father's extensive travels to the Holy Land has inspired him to write the "*Holy Land Prayer Book*," which has been published by his Jesuit apostolate, Ignatius Productions, in 2004 and can be used as a prayer book guide for any pilgrim traveling to the Holy Land. Father Pacwa also has the privilege of being bi-ritual, which means he also celebrates the Maronite Mass of the Eastern Catholic Church.
