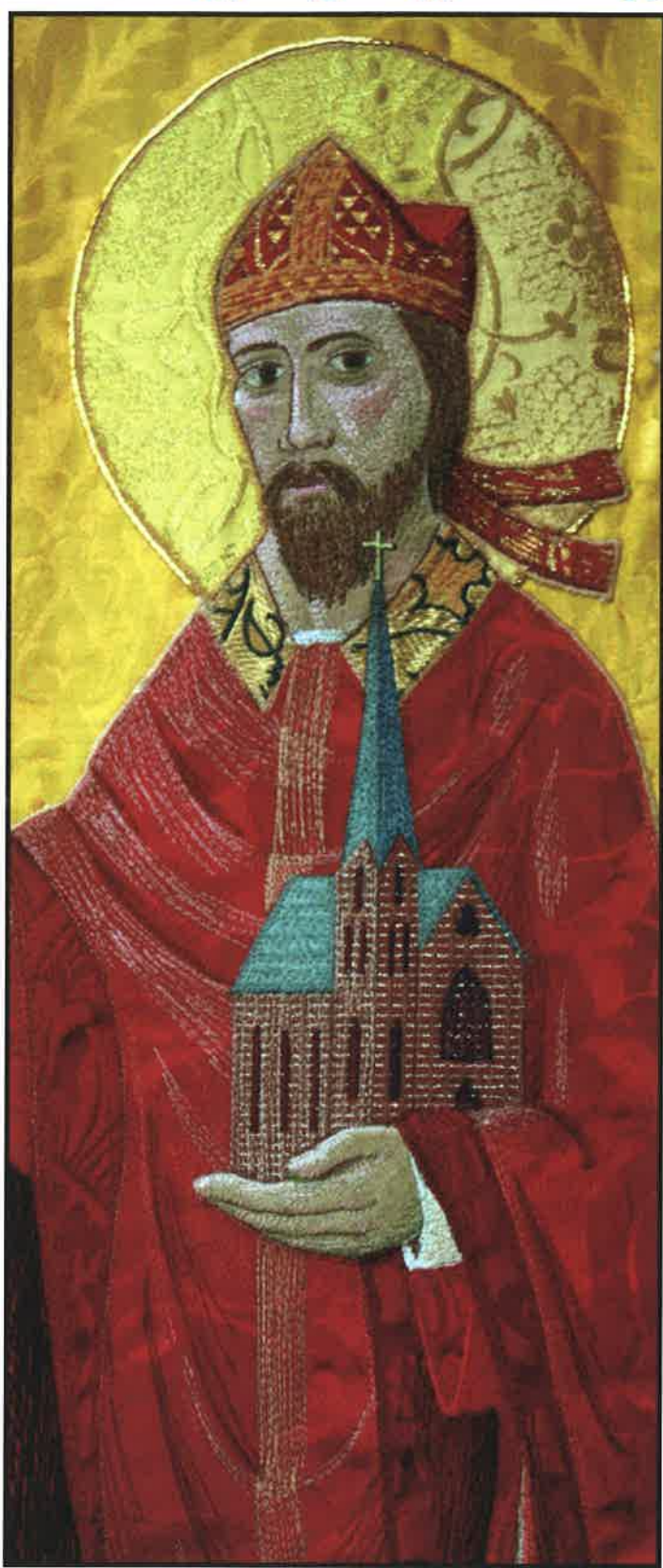

From a parochial vicar's desk...

On Saturday, April 30 (today or yesterday depending on when you're reading this) our candidates for Confirmation will be making their retreat at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation in Carey, Ohio. It'll be a wonderful day for our candidates to prayerfully prepare to be strengthened in the Holy Spirit at Confirmation on June 19. I'm grateful I'm able to join them. We'll have Mass as a group, and then in the afternoon participate in the pilgrimage devotions to Our Lady with the Albanian Catholics. We'll also be able to gain a plenary indulgence by passing through the holy doors at the basilica and fulfilling the other duties that go along with that indulgence which are Communion, prayers for Pope Francis, and Confession within 21 days.

As we recall at Pentecost the Apostles were filled with the Holy Spirit, and spoke in tongues as set off far and wide to preach the gospel. We'll probably hear some different languages while praying with the Albanians!

Let's continue to pray for our youth who are preparing for Confirmation in June. Let us entrust them to Our Lady of Consolation that she may protect them from all harm and temptations as they prepare to receive the gift of this sacrament. Moreover, let us pray that they truly open themselves up to the movement of the Holy Spirit in their lives through this great sacrament.
