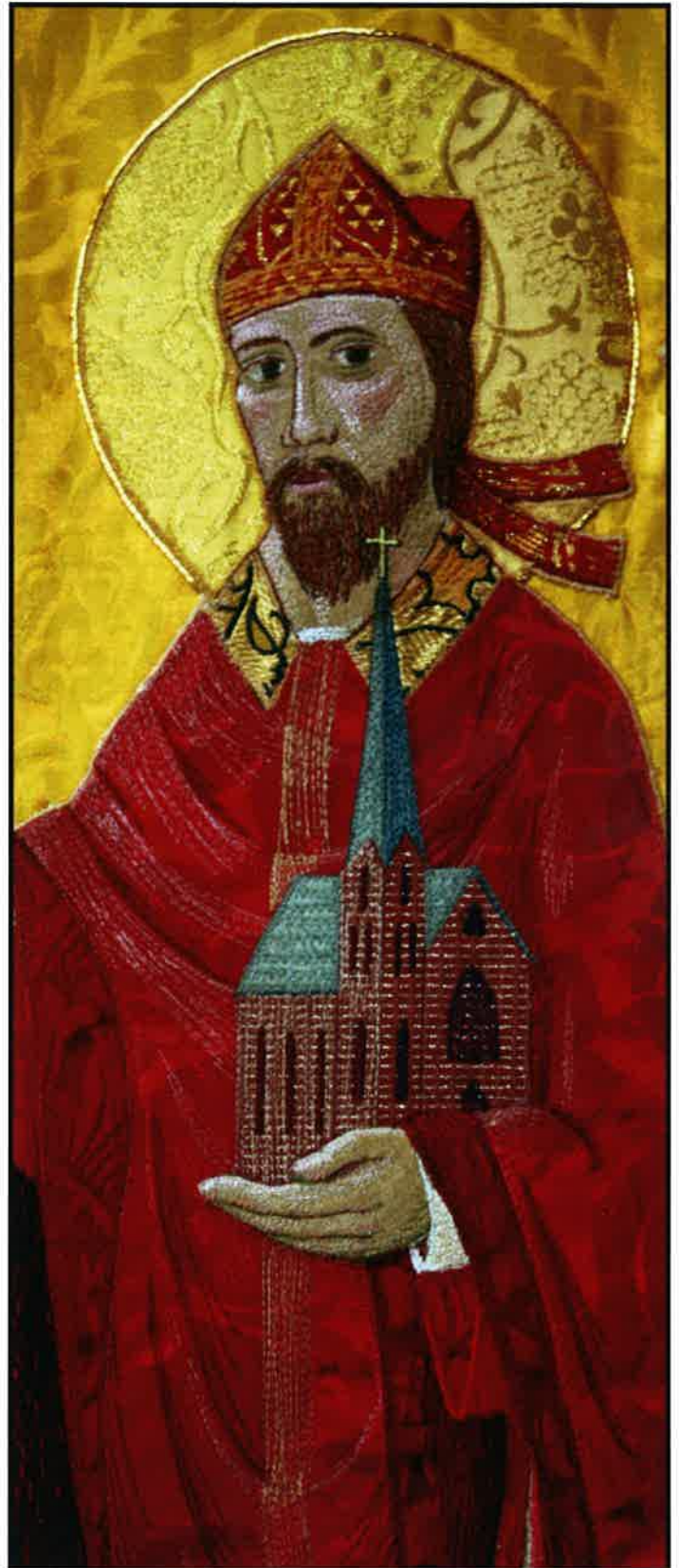

- ❖ Shirley Pettit will continue to decorate the church for feast days. Should your sponsorship fall during a feast day, Shirley will try to coordinate your request with the flowers she orders for that weekend as best as she can.
- ❖ Your sponsorship will be listed in the bulletin so that parishioners may also pray for your intentions.
- ❖ Sponsorships will be made through the Parish Office. You may complete the Flower Sponsorship Order form which can be found on the website, in the back of church or by emailing Tina in the Parish Office. Once you have the order form completed, you may drop your sponsorship check and order form in the collection basket or bring it to the Parish Office. Be sure to enclose the order form and check in a separate envelope marked "Flower Fund".
- ❖ Sponsorships must be made at least two weeks in advance. Sponsorships will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.
- ❖ The cost is \$40.00 per arrangement. Please make checks payable to St. Colman Catholic Church.
