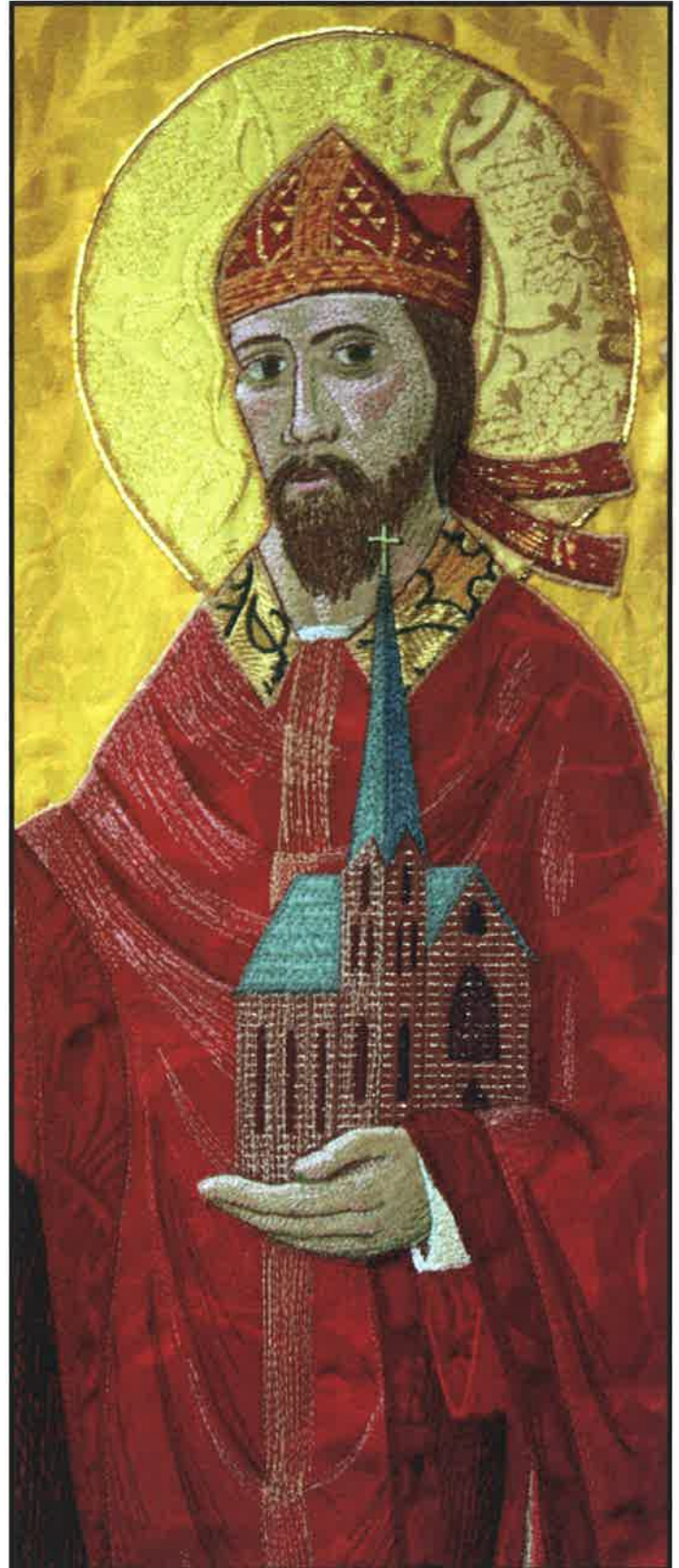

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

On Monday, we celebrate the memorial of the Martyrdom of St. John the Baptist, the great herald of the Messiah and the cousin of Jesus who leapt in the womb of St. Elizabeth at the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Why celebrate his beheading? Well, "by celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: 'He must increase, but I must decrease'" (CCC 524).

Where in our own lives can we decrease so that Christ may have a chance to increase? The fathers of the Second Vatican Council remind us: "Never has the human race enjoyed such an abundance of wealth, resources and economic power, and yet a huge proportion of the worlds citizens are still tormented by hunger and poverty, while countless numbers suffer from total illiteracy. Never before has man had so keen an understanding of freedom, yet at the same time new forms of social and psychological slavery make their appearance" (GS 4). It seems then that left to our own devices we are naturally inclined to increase our personal desires and comforts.

There may be times this week when we encounter an opportunity to decrease so that Christ may increase. In prayer let us go to St. John the Baptist and ask him to point out Christ to us in our daily lives visible in our neighbor, in the person in the pew in front of you, in the poor, in the social outcast at school, and in our families. Then be assured that the intercession of this great saint will assist you in allowing Christ to increase in your words and actions.
