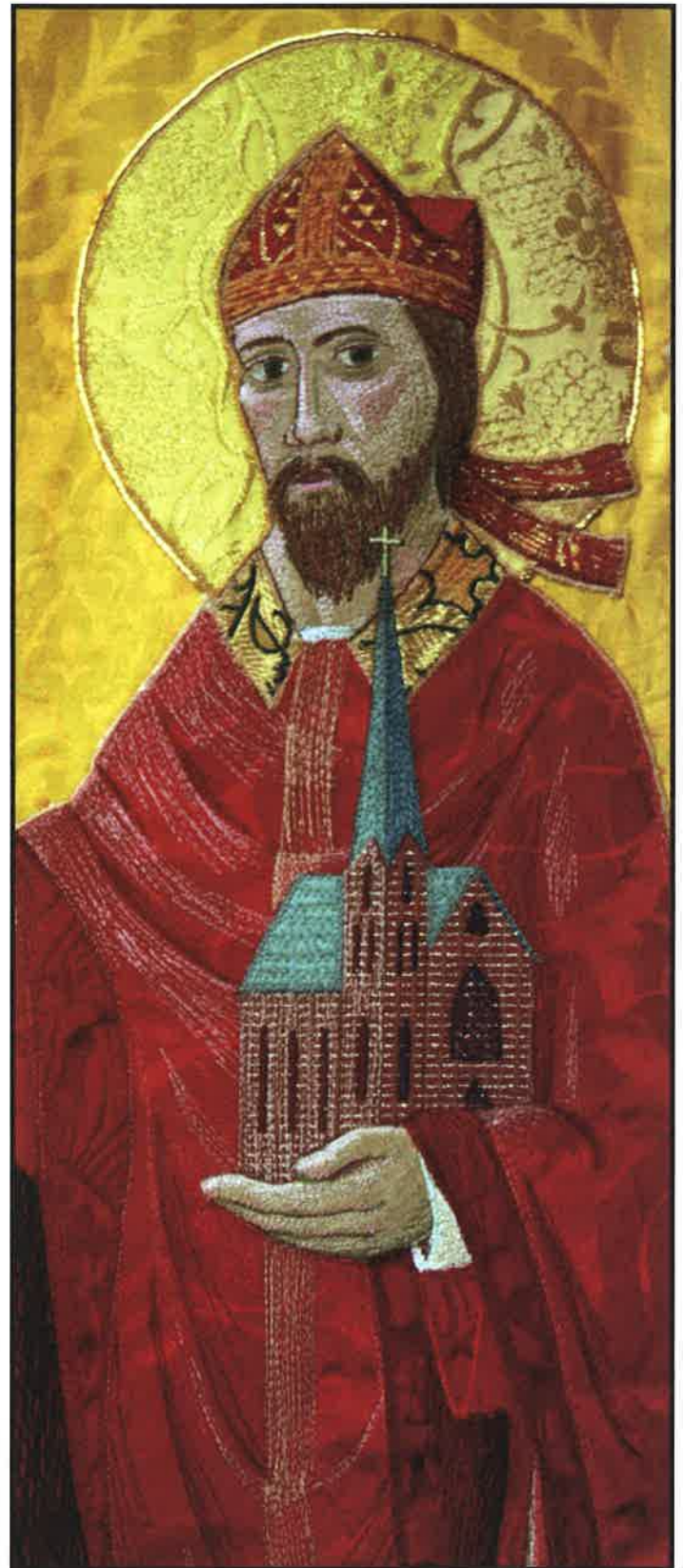

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany, when the Son of God is revealed as the Savior of the world to the three wise men from the East. (I know we three priests are three wise men from the East, but it was three different wise men from the East.) The Catechism tells us, "In the magi, representatives of the neighboring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first-fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation." (CCC 528)

Many are looking for that bright light in the world that points to the Savior. Jesus expects us to be that bright light. Pray that all Christians may more perfectly reflect the light of Christ to all nations, and that many more will come to believe that Jesus is the Son of God and Savior of the world.
