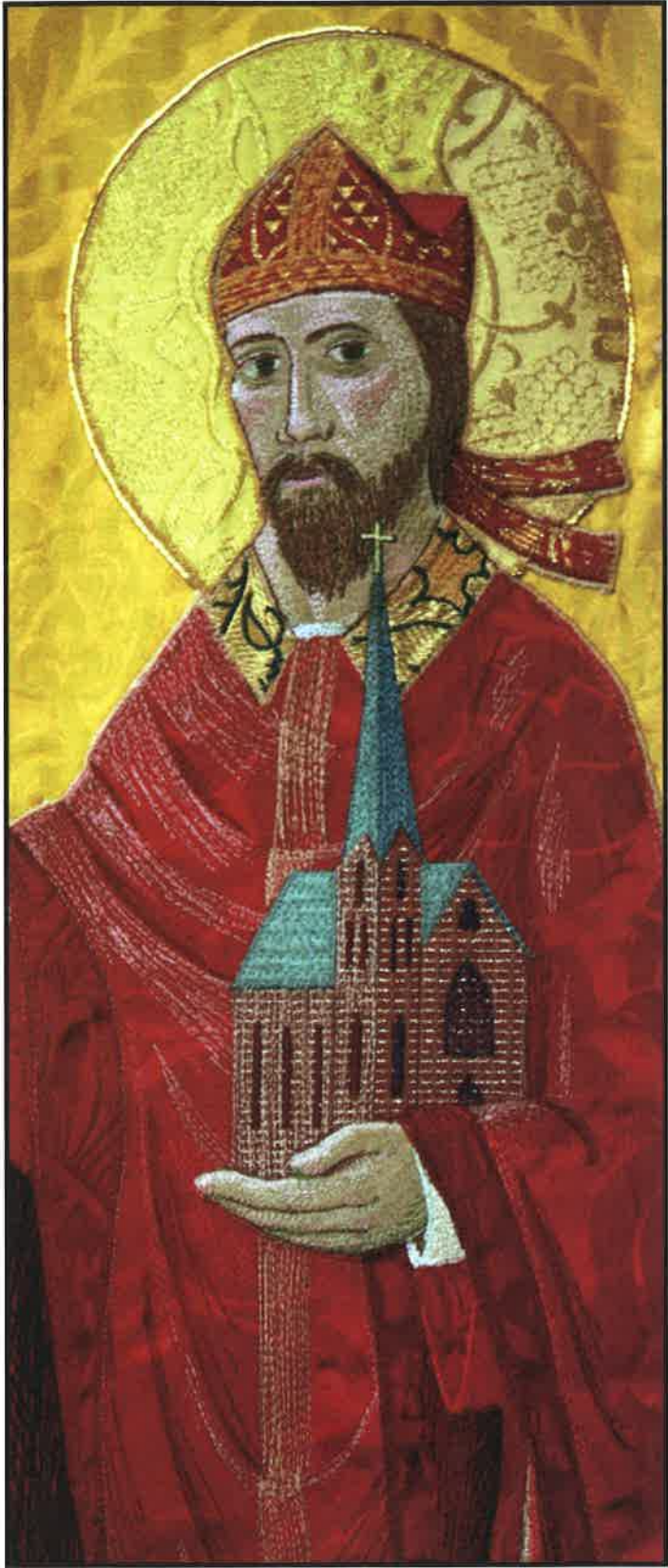

Wilderness Outreach Father and Son Expedition to the Great American West. August 4-13, 2017.

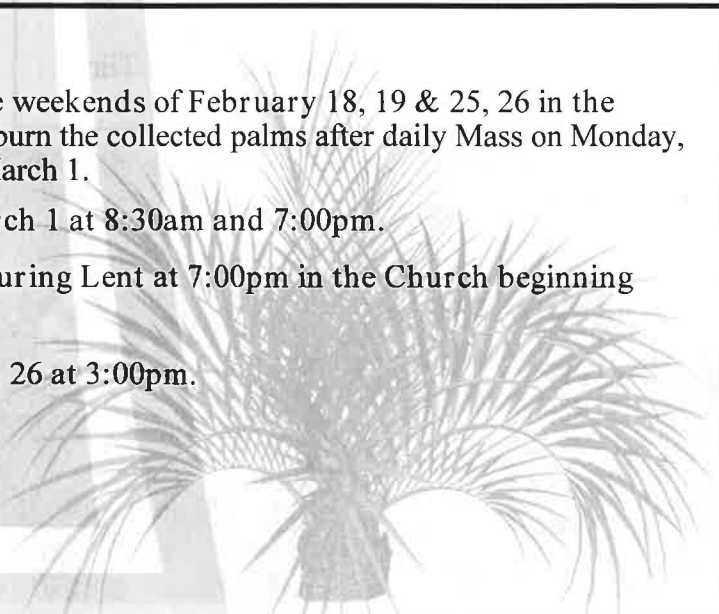
