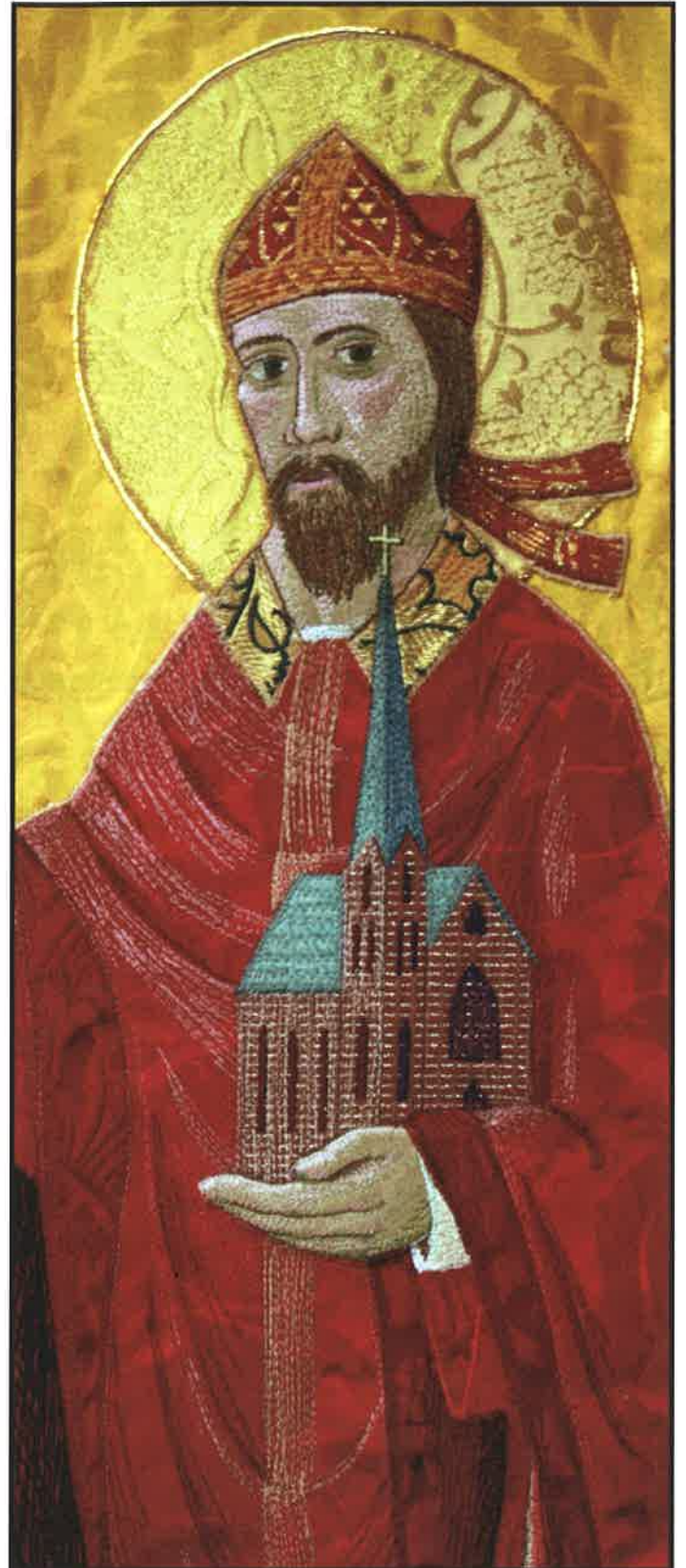

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

REMEMBER: FAST AND ABSTAIN FROM MEAT ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 1 (ASH WEDNESDAY) AND GOOD FRIDAY. ADDITIONALLY, ABSTAIN FROM MEAT ON FRIDAYS IN LENT.

From our United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) regarding fasting:

“Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.”

Fasting is a time honored method of penance that can greatly assist one in gaining self-mastery. If we deprive the body of something that it can legitimately have in normal circumstances (such as three full meals, or eating meat on other days) then we can much more easily say “No” to those things (sins, vices) that we cannot legitimately have.

Suggestions for Lenten prayer, fasting and almsgiving...

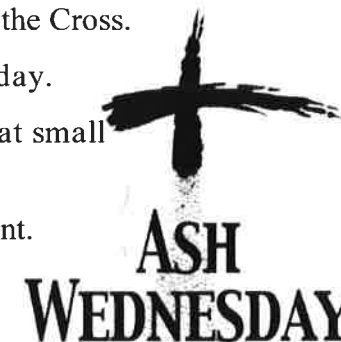
Prayer: Daily Rosary, 15 minutes of Reading Sacred Scripture and reflecting, and/or attend the weekly Stations of the Cross.

Fasting: Eating a small meal at lunch on Friday.

Almsgiving: Put that money you saved on that small Friday lunch in your rice bowl.
