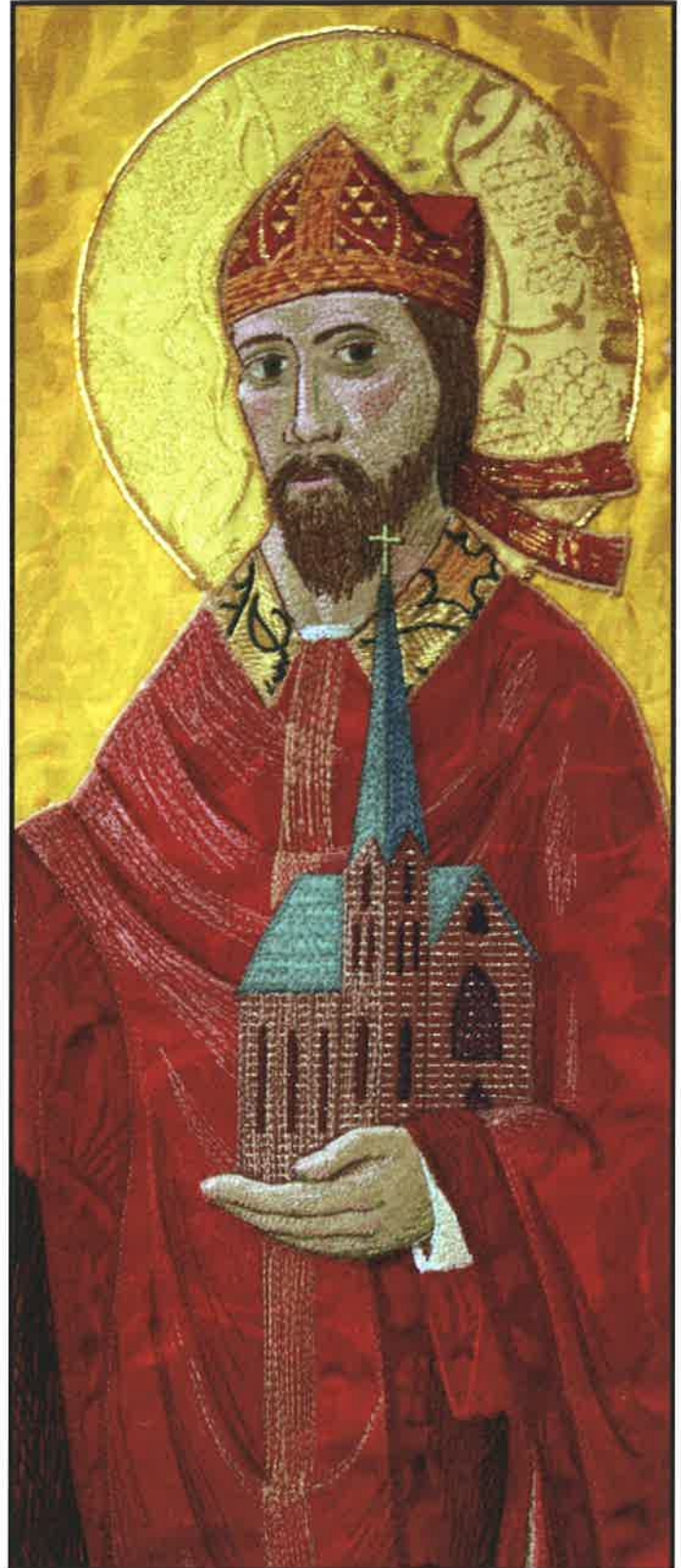

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

Sr. Faustina was a sister of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Poland in the 1930s. She was given extraordinary revelations from Jesus regarding the spread of the message of his abundant mercy to all. Jesus' mercy is offered to all, and "the greater the sinner, the greater the right he has to My mercy" (Diary 723). This beautiful message of mercy recorded in her personal diary was originally suppressed by the Church due to a faulty translation and misinterpretation of her diary. The great Polish Pope, John Paul II, insisted that the diary be reexamined, and it was found to be without error and worthy of public veneration and devotion in the universal Church. Sr. Faustina was canonized a saint in the year 2000. She was the first canonized saint of the new millennium.

Let us remember that Jesus' mercy overcomes all hardships. His mercy is bigger than us and our sins, yet approachable and inviting. Jesus can use us to spread his Divine Mercy. He's giving it in abundance to you at this very moment.

Mother's Day Spiritual Bouquets

Spiritual Bouquets are prayers, or in this case, Intentions that are offered by someone in honor of or memory of another. These are a wonderful way to commemorate special occasions or dates in the life of the family or the church. Everyone needs prayer and this is an opportunity to come together as a community in honor of someone who has been an important part of our lives: our Mothers, Grandmothers, Godmothers, Aunts or someone who has had a motherly influence in our lives.

The Bouquet consists of a card inside a donation envelope. A donation of \$10 is requested for each Intention. Divine Mercy Sunday Feast of Mercy - April 23, 2017

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sin and punishment.

Our Lord speaks: "Speak to the world about My mercy... it is a sign for the end times. After it will come the day of justice (Diary 848)...Souls perish in spite of My bitter passion... I am giving them the last hope of salvation; that is, the Feast of Mercy. If they will not adore My Mercy, they will perish for all eternity. Secretary of My mercy, write, tell souls about this great mercy of Mine, because the awful day, the day of My justice, is near" (Diary #965).

Our Lord speaks: "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon these souls that approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sin and punishment. On that day all the divine flood gates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity." (Diary 699).

Our Lord speaks: "The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the First Sunday after Easter (Diary 699)...I desire that priests proclaim this great mercy of Mine towards souls of sinners. Let the sinner not be afraid to approach Me, the flames of mercy are burning Me-clamoring to be spent; I want to pour them out upon these souls" (Diary 50).

Conditions of plenary indulgence for feast of mercy

Sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and prayer for the Pope and his intentions, on the second Sunday after Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in a spirit that is completely detached from sin, even venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament recite the Our Father or creed, or adding a prayer to the merciful Jesus (e.g. Jesus, I trust in You).

Due to our priest shortage, or grave condition (e.g., war, prison and sickness)

It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed; (Feast of Mercy) but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act. *—Cardinal William Wakefield Baum*

"TONES, TUNES and TEENS" will present the The Symphonic Choir of Hillsboro High School in concert in junction with an Easter Hymn Festival. Craig Jaynes, the Director of the Concerts in a Country Church series, said, "Our concerts normally feature professional musicians, and it may seem somewhat strange that we would be featuring a high school group for one of our programs. However, The Symphonic Choir from Hillsboro is anything but the usual school chorus. I can recall being bowled over the first time I ever heard them. One might be tempted to think that this was a one-time phenomenon resulting from a singular group of particularly talented kids, but it turns out not to be the case. David White is completing his fifteenth year as Director of Vocal Music at Hillsboro High School, where he has consistently produced a program of unsurpassed high quality. The choirs under his direction routinely produce superior ratings from adjudicated district and state level events. They also participate annually in at least one major choral work with orchestra, their alumni and the Hillsboro Community Chorus, the list of which would produce drools of envy from programs many times their size. They have been invited to this series not only as a recognition of their outstanding efforts over the years and their subsequent contribution to the musical life of southern Ohio but also because they present programs that will leave you with your mouth open in disbelief at the incredibly high level of quality singing produced. They will be coming to the series on the heels of participation at an internationally-renowned event at Westminster Choir College in Princeton, New Jersey."

In addition to presenting their own repertoire, the choir will serve as the lead for the audience to participate in an Easter Hymn Festival. The Hymn Festival format was introduced at one of last season's concerts and was rated high in popularity by those attending.

This year's festival will feature Easter hymns, some well-known and others not as familiar. The hymn verses will be interspersed by organ interpretations of their tunes which will be performed by Mr. Jaynes. The audience is expected to 'raise the roof' in celebratory song! "There is simply nothing quite like the experience of singing with other music lovers, at the top of your voice, surrounded by other strong voices, with a great instrument for support, in an acoustic that creates a whole that is greater than the sum of its parts. It's a real thrill!" Jaynes added.
