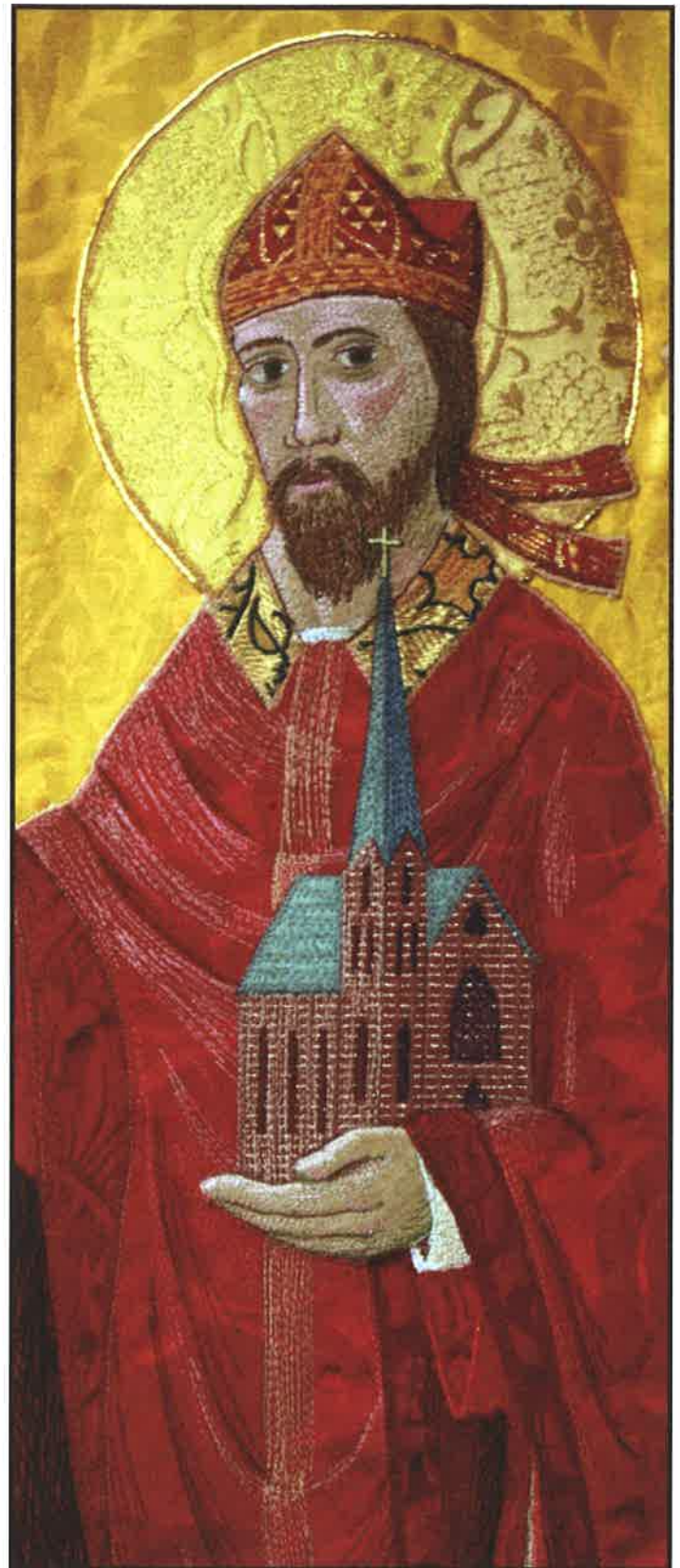

## From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

**Happy Veterans' Day** to all of our veterans! The annual observance of Veterans Day in the United States on November 11th has its roots in the armistice that ended World War I hostilities in 1918. The armistice between the Allied nations and Germany went into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month. President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed thereafter that November 11 be observed as "Armistice Day." In 1954, Congress passed legislation that renamed the federal holiday "Veterans Day," in recognition of the service of veterans of all U.S. Wars. Let us also remember those chaplains of the armed forces who provided for the spiritual health of our veterans as they protected our freedoms.

We also are reminded that Sunday, November 12th is designated as **Stewardship Sunday**. I am so grateful for the way people give very freely of their time and talent here at St. Colman. This parish is alive and vibrant because of so many loving and giving parishioners. Our weekly offertory continues to be very stable, so thank you as well for such incredible financial generosity! No matter what we have received from the Lord, we are expected to be careful stewards of our many gifts. The Lord cannot be outdone in generosity, so let us remember that we owe back to God a pleasing sacrifice from our first fruits, that is the best of what we have to offer (see *Genesis 4:1-16 describing the account of Cain and Able and Luke 21:1-4 for vivid reminders of this expectation*). ## Bi-Monthly Healing Mass on November 20 at Saint Joseph Cathedral

A Mass of Healing and Healing Service will be celebrated on Monday, November 20, 6:30 p.m. at Saint Joseph Cathedral, 212 East Broad Street, Columbus. Following the Mass, a Service of Healing will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Veneration of relic of the True Cross of Christ, followed by an opportunity for each person to speak individually with a priest and receive prayers of healing for what they seek; the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will also be available. The Service of Healing will conclude with Benediction. All persons who seek Christ's healing are invited – especially those who suffer with physical illness and infirmities (e.g. cancer and other debilitating diseases and conditions), in addition to those in seek emotional and spiritual healing. All caregivers, family members, and members of the medical community are invited as well. Parking is available at the rear of the Cathedral accessible off East Gay Street; handicap accessible elevator is located in the courtyard (west side of the Cathedral) on East Broad Street. Bi-monthly Healing Masses take place at the Cathedral on the third Monday of the month; this is the last Healing Mass for 2017. During 2018 Healing Masses are scheduled for: January 15, March 19, May 21, July 16, September 17, and November 19. ## PICK OF THE WEEK, NOVEMBER 12, 2017



**FORMED** THE CATHOLIC FAITH, ON DEMAND.

Emil Kapaun—priest, soldier and Korean War hero—was a rare man. He was awarded posthumously the Medal of Honor, the nation's highest military award, and is also being considered by the Vatican for canonization as a saint. Just as remarkable are the many non-Catholic witnesses who attest to Father Kapaun's heroism: the Protestants, Jews, and Muslims who either served with the military chaplain in the thick

of battle or endured with him the incredibly brutal conditions of a prisoner of war camp. These Korean War veterans, no matter their religion, agree that Father Kapaun did more to save lives and maintain morale than any other man they know. Then there are the alleged miracles—the recent healings attributed to Father Kapaun's intercession that defy scientific explanation. Under investigation by the Vatican as a necessary step in the process of canonization, these cures witnessed by non-Catholic doctors are also covered in this book. In tracking down the story of Father Kapaun for the Wichita Eagle, Wenzl and Heying uncovered a paradox. Kapaun's ordinary background as the son of Czech immigrant farmers in Kansas sowed the seeds of his greatness. His faith, generosity, and grit began with his family's humility, thrift and hard work.
