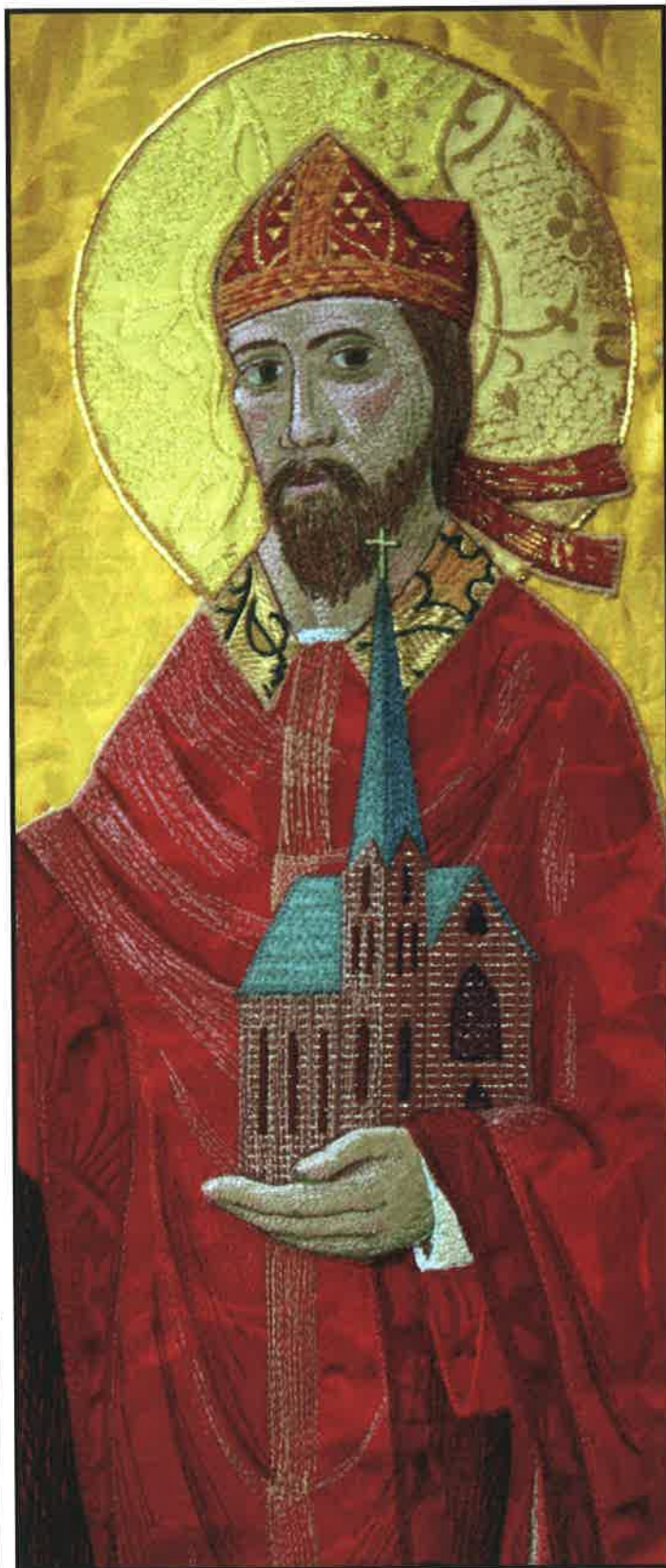

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK From a parochial vicar's desk...

In the past week and a half it's been my pleasure to be involved in two events promoting the sanctity of life. Last Thursday I served as MC for a fundraiser for **Bethesda Post-Abortion Healing Ministry** in Columbus. The night was a joyful glimpse into the healing offered to those who suffer from the wounds of abortion. Bethesda offers healing sessions to women and men who have had abortions. For 22 years they have meet every other Monday in an environment that allows people to come together for a meal, prayer, Confession if they are Catholic, and time to embrace the mercy of Jesus through group discussions. I spent time with them as a seminarian in these healing sessions, and I witnessed what his tender ministry can do for people who have had abortions. This type of good work lets those who have had abortions and suffer from its negative effects know that there is forgiveness for them, and that the Lord still has good work in can do in and through them. On Tuesday here in Washington Courthouse, we blessed the new site of the **L.I.F.E. Pregnancy Center** adjacent to our campus. It was a privilege for me to bless the property and pray with the local ministers and faithful for the success of the building project. During the service, our noon Angelus bells rang out as if Our Lady was giving her unwavering approval of our prayers for this new site and the good work that will go in within the walls to be constructed. 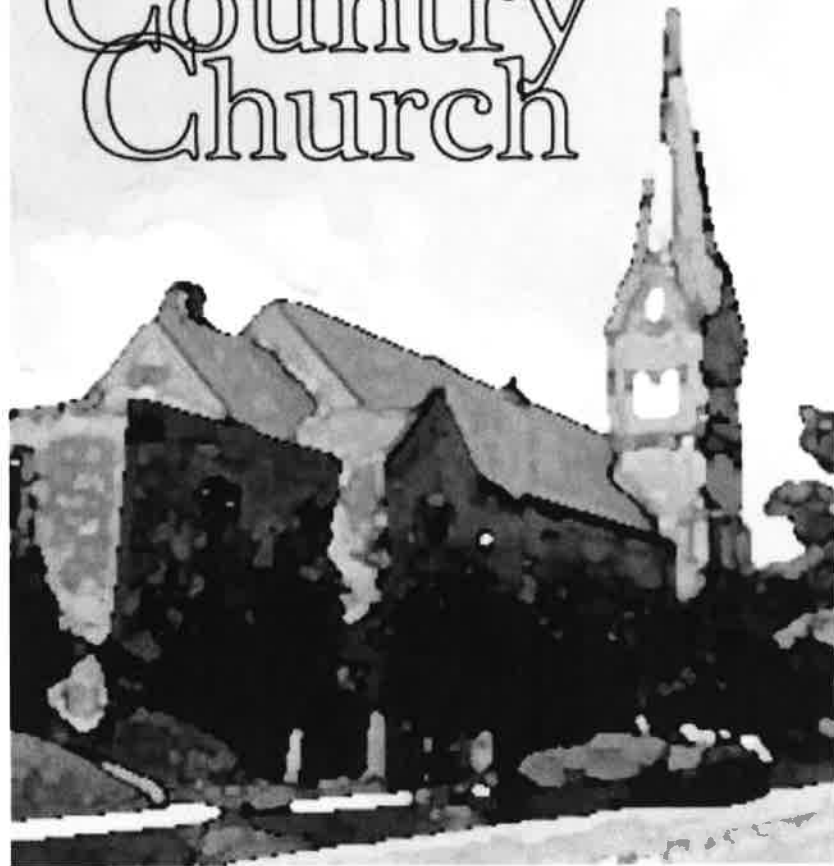
