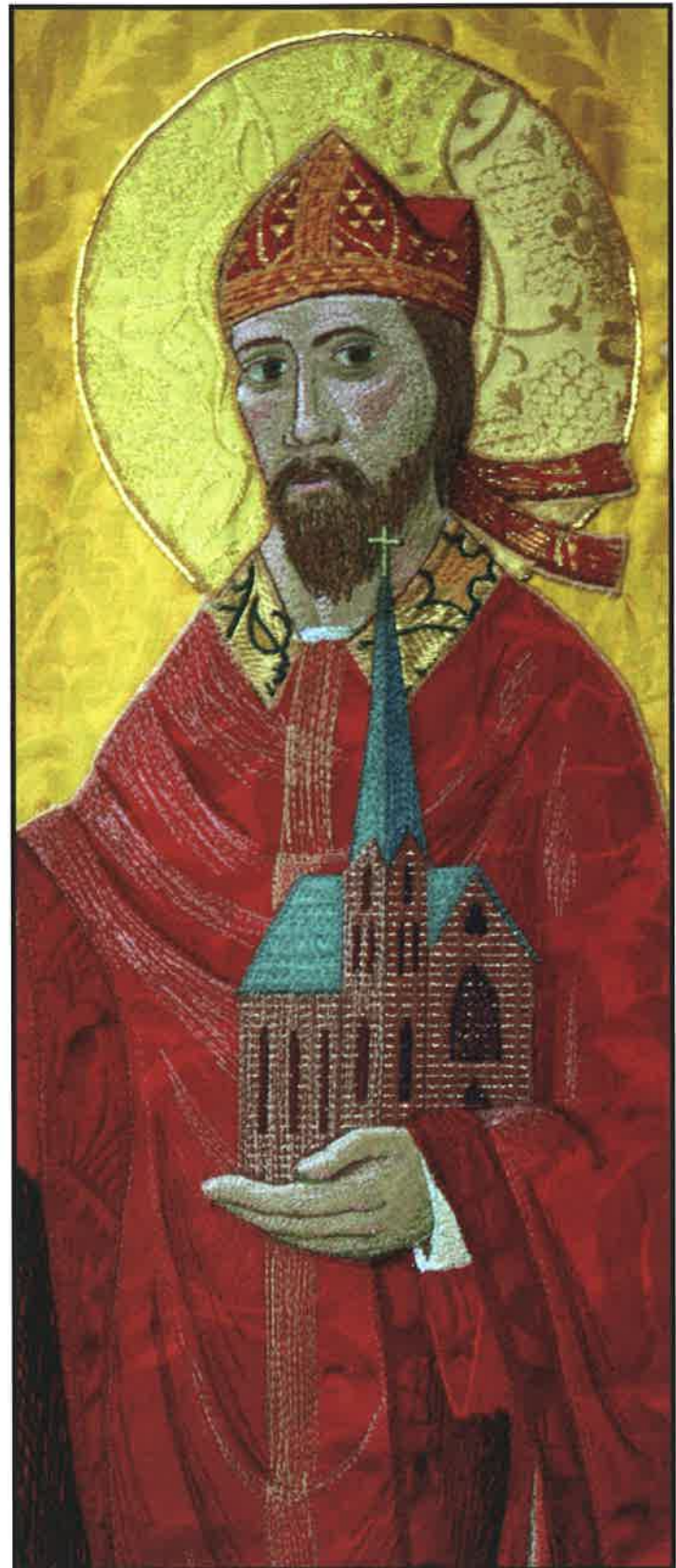

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### From a parochial vicar's desk...

Counterintuitive to our seasonal calendar, Pentecost for the Jewish people was called the Feast of Harvest or Feast of Weeks. When Pentecost comes, we're still planting. Our harvest festivals are now in the autumn, and they aren't religious, although many farmers are surely thanking God when the harvest is finally complete! The Jews calculated the "Pentecost," as the Feast later became known, seven weeks after Passover. "Pentecost" comes from a Greek word meaning fifty, and it was one of three major feasts on their calendar.

For us, too, Pentecost is a major feast ranking third in importance only to Easter and Christmas. It's the great feast we celebrate when fifty days after the Resurrection the Holy Spirit was sent upon the Apostles gathered in Jerusalem so they could give witness to the world, and bring in the harvest of souls into the Church. It is remembered as the day the Church was born as the bearer of God's Spirit to the world. As Jesus reminds us in Matthew 9:37, "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." How can each of us labor for the word of God and contribute to the harvest? Is there someone you used to see at Mass that you no longer do? Can you labor just a bit by a simple phone call to him or her inviting them back?

Each Sunday we can think of this beautiful church as a heavenly silo. Let's fill it with those hungry for the word of God! Let us labor for the Lord seeking out those among us who need an invitation to be gathered back in. The harvest is abundant!
