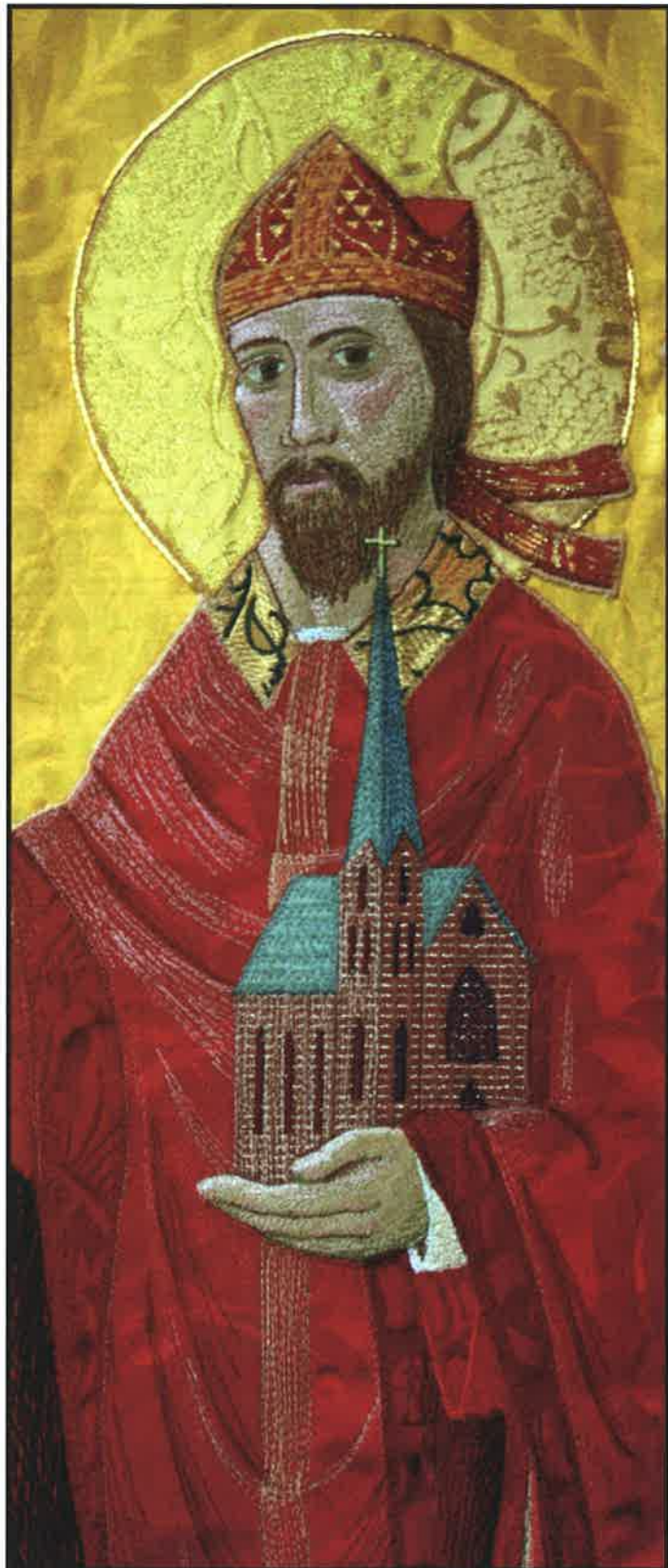

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

Bishop Campbell has approved the weekend of June 4-5 as the **third annual My House Sexual Integrity Weekend** to promote awareness about the dangers of pornography addiction and the call to sexual integrity for all Catholics. Bringing attention to such issues can be uncomfortable but necessary in walking the path of Christian discipleship. Such addictions are as harmful to the soul and the integrity of the person as illicit drug use can be on the body. When helping a family member addicted to drugs the goal is healing, not shame. Addressing sin is never to shame, but always to heal.

Additionally, it is first and foremost the responsibility of parents to address the danger of pornography addiction with filters such as www.covenanteyes.com when children and youth have immediate access to such images, even accidentally, via personal computers, Ipads, and smart phones. Please read *Catechism of the Catholic Church* paragraph number 2354 for further clarity. You may also reference *YouCat* paragraphs 412 and 460 with your youth.

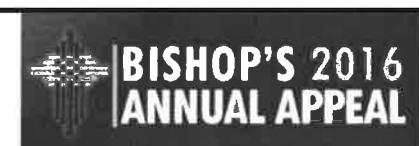

My House Awareness Weekend

As Fr. Hartge mentioned in his column, this weekend is My House Awareness Weekend. "My House" refers to the Scripture, "As for me and *my house*, we will serve the Lord" - Joshua 24:15

My House Columbus is an organization that helps men and women accomplish this by providing resources in battling pornography and achieving purity.

One of the most important tools that they recommend is an internet filter. Consider the following:

Don't leave your door unlocked.

How many of you parents, as the last thing before going to bed, check each door and make sure they are locked and that your kids are safe and secure? And yet so many homes have another entrance that parents forget about. An entrance that can put a child in the middle of a lewd and dangerous place with the click of a button. An entrance through which people can come and steal their child's innocence and his or her freedom. An entrance that can be substantially blocked if parents take the time to investigate the resources. I am of course speaking of the internet. It has changed our lives profoundly, and much has been for the good. However, there is an underside – and this is the unfettered access to all of the world and all of its dangers.

Curious?

As children, we were all curious. This is why there were gates when we were little and curfews when we were older. Children are meant to be protected. Children are still developing their intellect and will power. No child should have to contend with the temptations of something as strong as pornography. Curiosity pulls one towards the mystery of sexuality. For all of human history until the last two decades there was a natural buffer to this curiosity: the unavailability of easily obtained images and information. Now it is everywhere. Statistics show that 90% of children aged 8-16 have viewed pornography, most without even intending to at first.

Whose fault?

I contend that a parent who gives their child access to a computer or smart phone without first ensuring that there is strong filtering software installed is complicit in any corruption of their child that may occur. To say it again, children need to be protected, (and yes teenagers are still children). In this arena, the home is meant to be a safe place; communication devices like phones and iPads are meant to be safe tools.

How to filter

There are many options. Two of the ones most recommended are these:

Net Nanny – filters out and reports any attempts to view pornography. Can be configured to mask profane language on webpages and monitor social media. Can also limit when the internet can be used, either amount of time or time periods (for example-no net access after 9:00 p.m. or no more than an hour of access each day). Very user-friendly. www.netnanny.com (\$40, \$60, or \$90 per year depending on how many devices)

Covenant Eyes – promoted by My House Columbus – filter and accountability software, similar to Net Nanny (\$130-\$170 per year) (www.covenanteyes.com)

Many are paying more per MONTH to bring the world into the home than what it costs per YEAR to start blocking out the bad parts of it.

Of course, this is not only for children. These filters can be set up to help adults keep a clean computer and can also include accountability partners. Subscribers can choose either a friend to be that partner or the company provides one as part of the package. This combination of filter and accountability has been proven to be the most effective method to achieving purity and freedom from pornography addiction.
