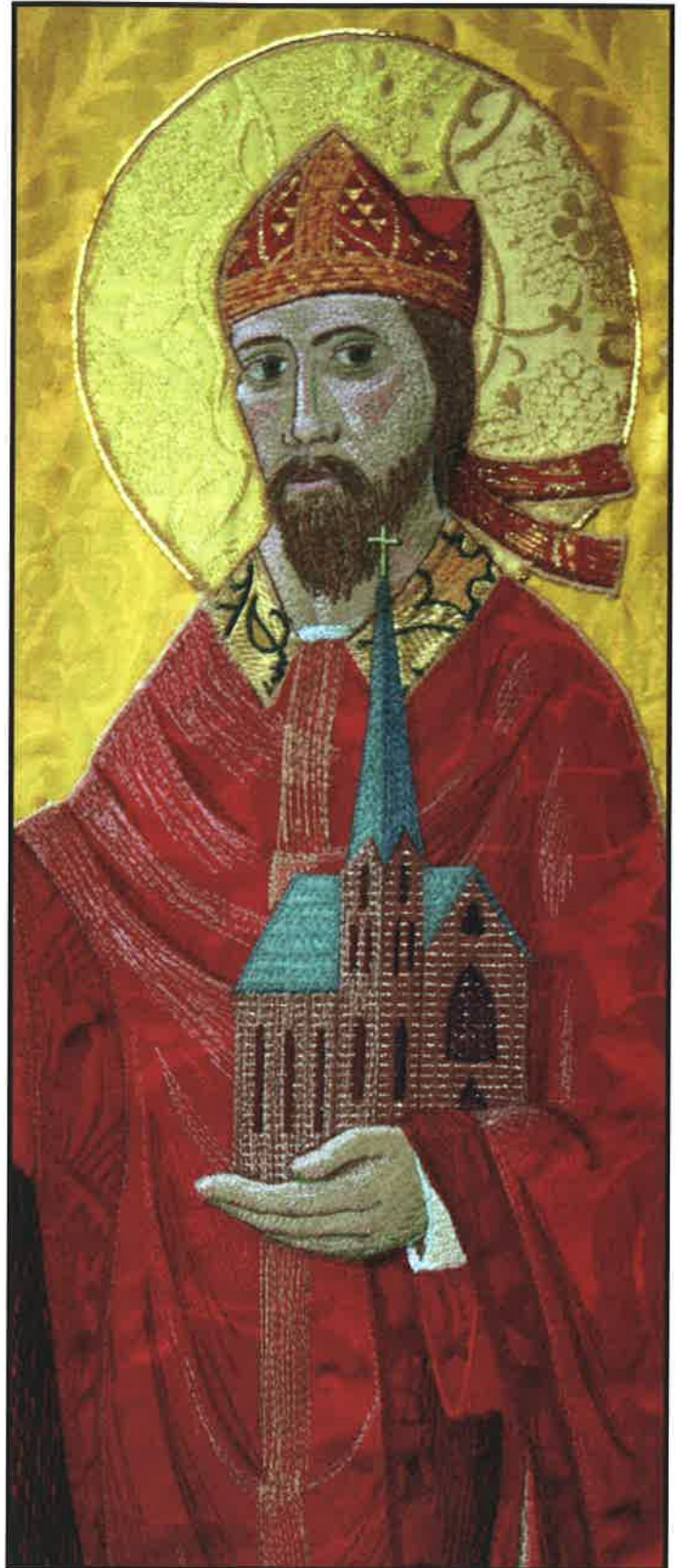

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

I would like to thank all of you, who after both Masses kept the sacred space of our church so quiet and conducive to prayer. Let's continue this practice, and go even deeper to understand the role of silence in our busy lives. Fellowship has been, and will continue to be, encouraged here at our parish, but in its proper setting. In the church itself and especially before and after Mass, quiet time for prayer should be our priority. Here's what the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) has to say to us about silence in the liturgy:

"Sacred silence also, as part of the celebration, is to be observed at the designated times. Its nature, however, depends on the moment when it occurs in the different parts of the celebration. For the Penitential Act and again after the invitation to pray, individuals recollect themselves; whereas after a reading or after the Homily; then after Communion, they praise God in their hearts and pray to him. Even before the celebration itself, it is a praiseworthy practice for silence to be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred celebration in a devout and fitting manner." (GIRM 45)

I would add that silence, in order to make a prayer of thanksgiving after Mass, is also a praiseworthy practice. Some prelude and postlude organ music has been and will continue to assist us in maintaining this prayerful atmosphere in our church.

LIFE Pregnancy Center's New Building and the Land

In this letter, I wanted to give some more information about the land transfer deal I mentioned a couple of months ago. This was when I announced that we were able to work out a deal for the LIFE Pregnancy Center to take over the mortgage payments on the land that is on the corner of our property. This allows us to help this important ministry out and at the same time allows us to see the corner of our property transformed by the addition of a beautiful building whose architecture will compliment our existing buildings.

History of the parcel

In 2003 this piece of land came up for sale. Because it adjoins the parish's it was thought a wise investment to purchase it. The purchase price was \$74,473.07. As you remember there was a storage building on the property that we were able to use for over 10 years before it became too unsightly and unsafe and needed to be taken down. For 5 years we paid the mortgage on the property until in 2008 the diocese assumed the loan and continued with the payments. At that point we had paid \$11,711.33 in loan payments, which is our total investment in the land and building that we had use of for ten years.

History of the transfer

Earlier last year the LIFE Pregnancy Center expressed interest in the land. I contacted the diocese who informed me that because of the important services they provided in our community and the Center's reputation that they would be happy to work with the Center on a transfer. They agreed to sell the land in exchange for the Center repaying the diocese the principal amount that we had not paid, \$62,761.74 with the diocese financing it interest free. After consultation with the finance council, I told them we would support this plan as we know how crucial the work the LIFE Pregnancy Center is in our community as an organization that literally saves lives. The diocese and the Center then proceeded with the plan and this is how the transfer occurred.

Investing in the Community

We were very proud, as Catholics, when shortly after the deal was announced, the Catholic Foundation announced that they would contribute \$20,000 to the project of building the center. In addition, already a dozen churches in Fayette County have pledged monetary support of the project with \$230,000 of the \$400,000 needed having already been pledged by churches and individuals. This is truly an ecumenical project and it is good that we can help out and at the same time, ourselves be blessed, with a nice building put on a spot that has been a bit of an eyesore in more recent years. In the future, we will conduct some fundraising efforts within the parish to help get the Center to its goal. I thank you for your continued support of such needed services in our community. I have been very impressed at the number of St. Colman parishioners involved in various community service organizations in Washington Court House. This is truly a great example of the mission of the laity to transform culture.
