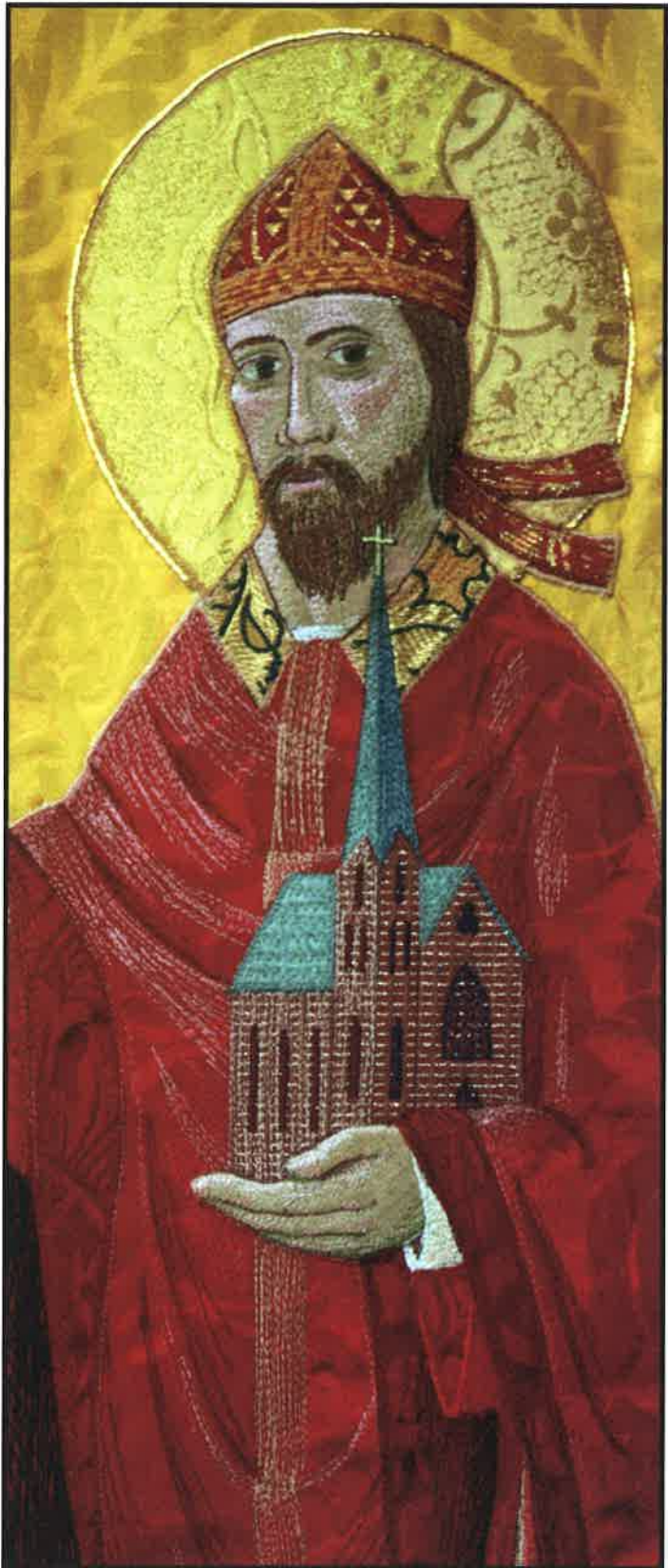

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

Monday, August 15 is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It's ordinarily a Holy Day of Obligation, but not so this year. This celebrates Our Lady's being taken up into heaven body and soul at the end of her earthly life. The Assumption is a Dogma of our faith and is to be held by all Catholics. Pope Pius XII pronounced definitively what was already held by the faithful, when from the Chair of St. Peter in 1950 he affirmed that in order to be more closely conformed to her son, Mary was taken up in heavenly glory at the end of her life on earth.

This is a singular grace from the Paschal Mystery of Jesus given to his Immaculate Mother. As her sons and daughters, let us then trust in her powerful intercession for us and for our family members. Let us trust that in watching her innocent son suffer and die for us, she suffered more severely than anything we might suffer. Let us also have the confidence then that she was rewarded beyond our imagining with her Assumption for remaining faithful amidst great suffering. Along with the Resurrection, this is where we place our hope when we're enduring pain and suffering, in whatever form it may come.
