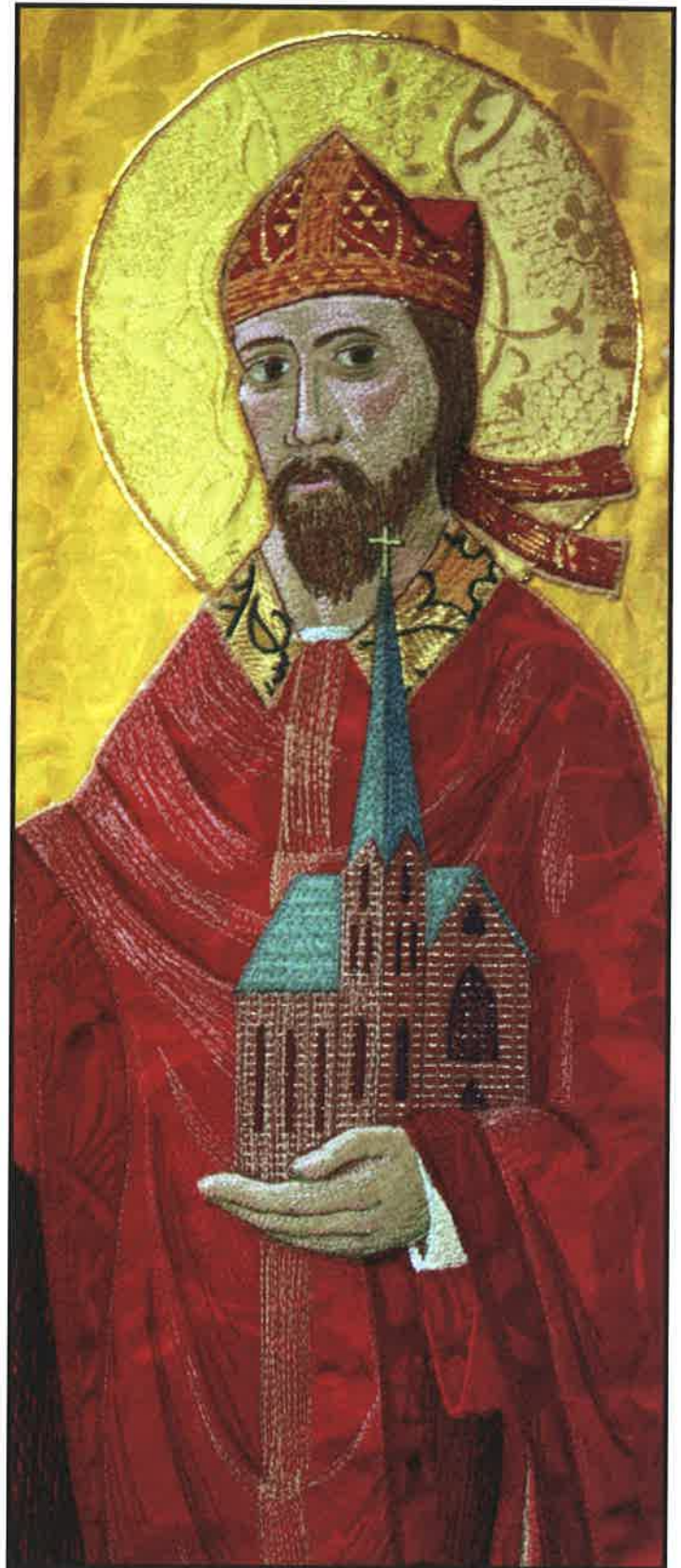

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

F Saint Mother Teresa! We've known that for a long time, but this Sunday, September 4, it will be official as Pope Francis canonizes Mother Teresa in St. Peter Square. She once commented, "Holiness is not the luxury of the few, but the simple duty of each one of us."

Do we consider it a duty of ours to grow in holiness? We are so attentive to our day-to-day duties and obligations, how often do we consider that we are each expected to be saints. Jesus expects that we grow to be saints. This is why the sacraments are so readily available to us, especially the Eucharist.

Mother Teresa had such a love for the priesthood and the Eucharist. She expected holiness from the priests she encountered. How could a priest, or anyone who met her, not deeply desire holiness after meeting her? Not only because of her good works, but because of her love for the Eucharist. It was the Eucharist that gave her the strength to pick up that first dying person off the street of Calcutta. It was the Eucharist that gave her the strength to endure years of a strong feeling that God had somehow abandoned her in her work. It was the Eucharist that transformed her works of mercy and charity into actions that would save her soul and the souls of so many.

The Eucharist absolutely can do the same for each one of us. Mother Teresa responded with a generous "yes" to Jesus' invitation to do very difficult work for love of him. We receive the same Eucharist she did. She let the Eucharist transform her into a saint. Will you?
