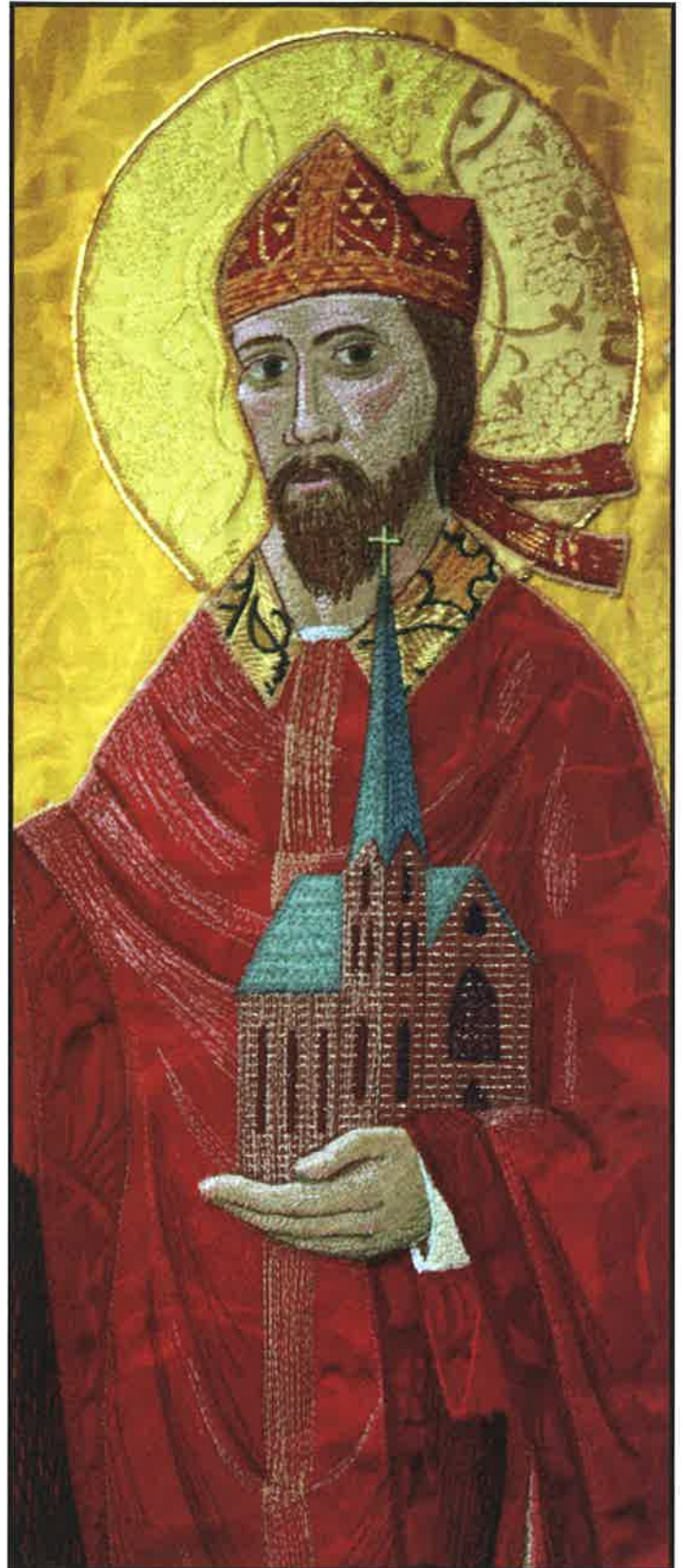

CONCERTS IN A COUNTRY CHURCH
