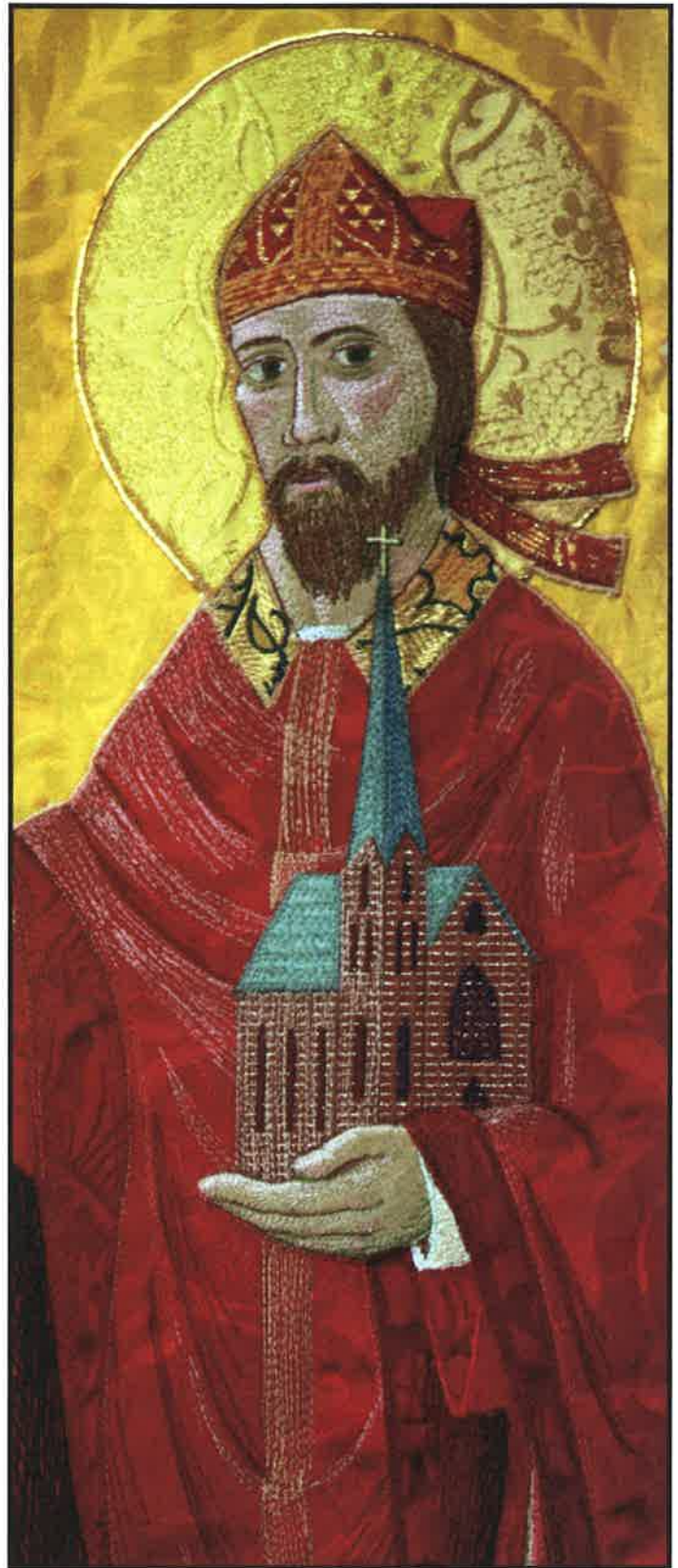

From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

The **March for Life Trip and Pilgrimage** to the Basilica Shrine of the Immaculate Conception was a great success. It all went very smoothly, and we were grateful to be part of such a large gathering of people supporting the lives of the unborn. Thursday afternoon we visited the St. John Paul II Shrine. It has a tremendous museum about his life and beautiful chapels. In one chapel is a vial of his blood, a first class relic. Many of us prayed for families in the presence of the relic of this great saint who championed the family during his whole pontificate. I happily included the families of St. Colman in my prayers. On Saturday we visited the Shrine of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the first native born American saint, and had Mass at the shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes on the campus of Mount St. Mary University in Emmitsburg, Maryland.

Next weekend we will have **Anointing of the Sick** at both Masses. This will take place after the homily. **Who can receive this sacrament?** Elderly people may be anointed if they are in weak condition even if there is no serious illness present, those with a serious and life threatening illness, and even sick children who have sufficient use of reason. Effects of this sacrament are: 1) uniting of the sick person to the cross of Christ, 2) Giving the sick person strength to endure such trials of infirmity, 3) forgiveness of sins if they are not able to confess their sins in the sacrament of confession, 4) restoration of health, 5) preparation for passing into eternal life. Our homebound and nursing home residents will all be anointed before Lent.
