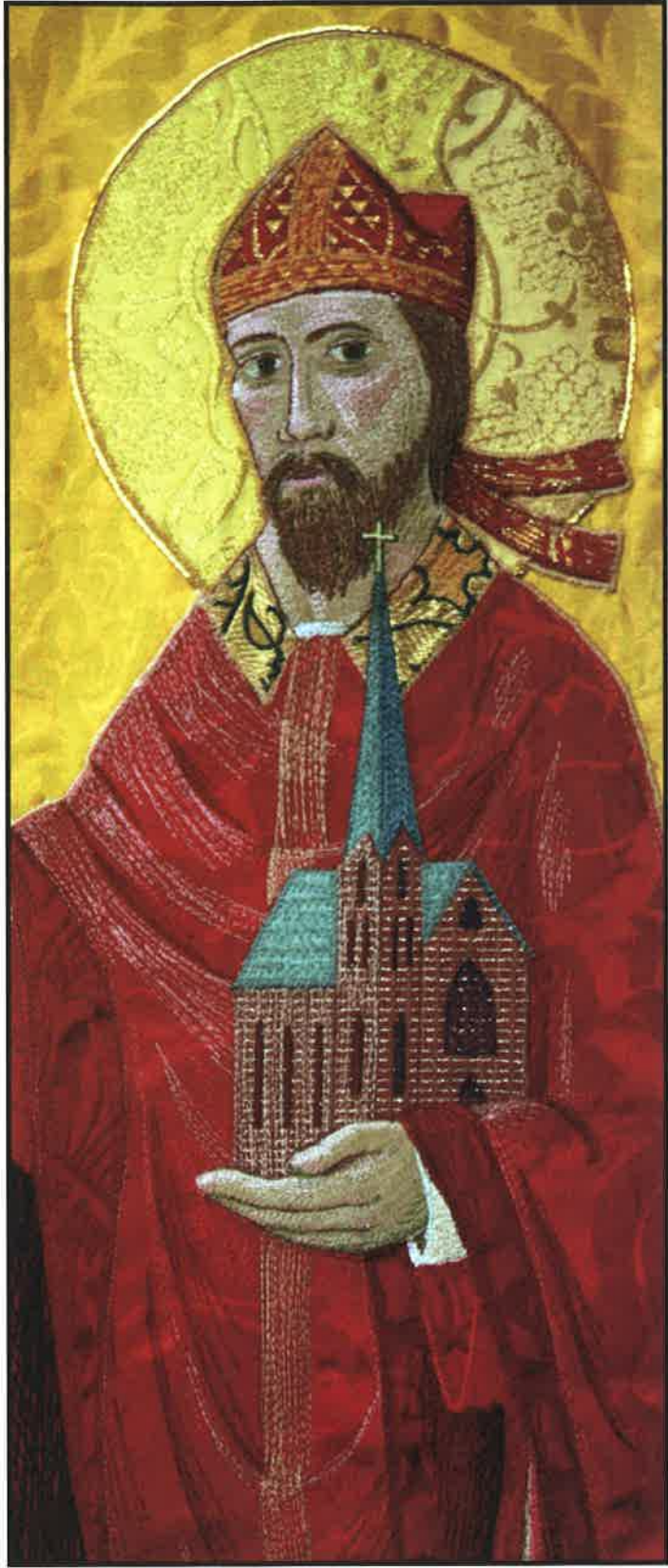

Salmon Spicy Fish Cutlet

Ingredients:

1 lb Boneless Canned Salmon, drained

Coriander powder 1 tsp

Turmeric powder: 1/4 tsp

Black pepper powder: 1/2 tsp

Garlic cloves: 1 tsp chopped

Onion: 1 (large, finely chopped)

Potato: 2 (large, boiled, peeled and smashed)

Ginger: 1 tbsp (finely chopped)

Green Chilies: 2 (finely chopped)

Coriander leaves: few (finely chopped)

Cilantro: finely chopped

Bread crumbs: 1 cup

Eggs: 2, Salt to taste, Corn flour: a pinch, Oil for frying

Heat 3 tsp oil in a pan, sauté chopped onion, ginger, garlic, green chili, curry leaves and coriander leaves until browned. Add turmeric, coriander powder, black pepper. Continue to sauté for a minute. Add salmon and mix well. Then add mashed potatoes and bread crumbs and mix well. Then cut and make into a small shape or round, dip each cutlet in the beaten egg. Fry cutlet in the oil until browned. Then serve with spicy tomato sauce.

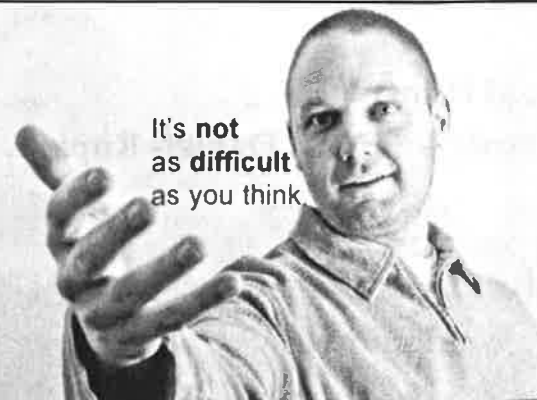
