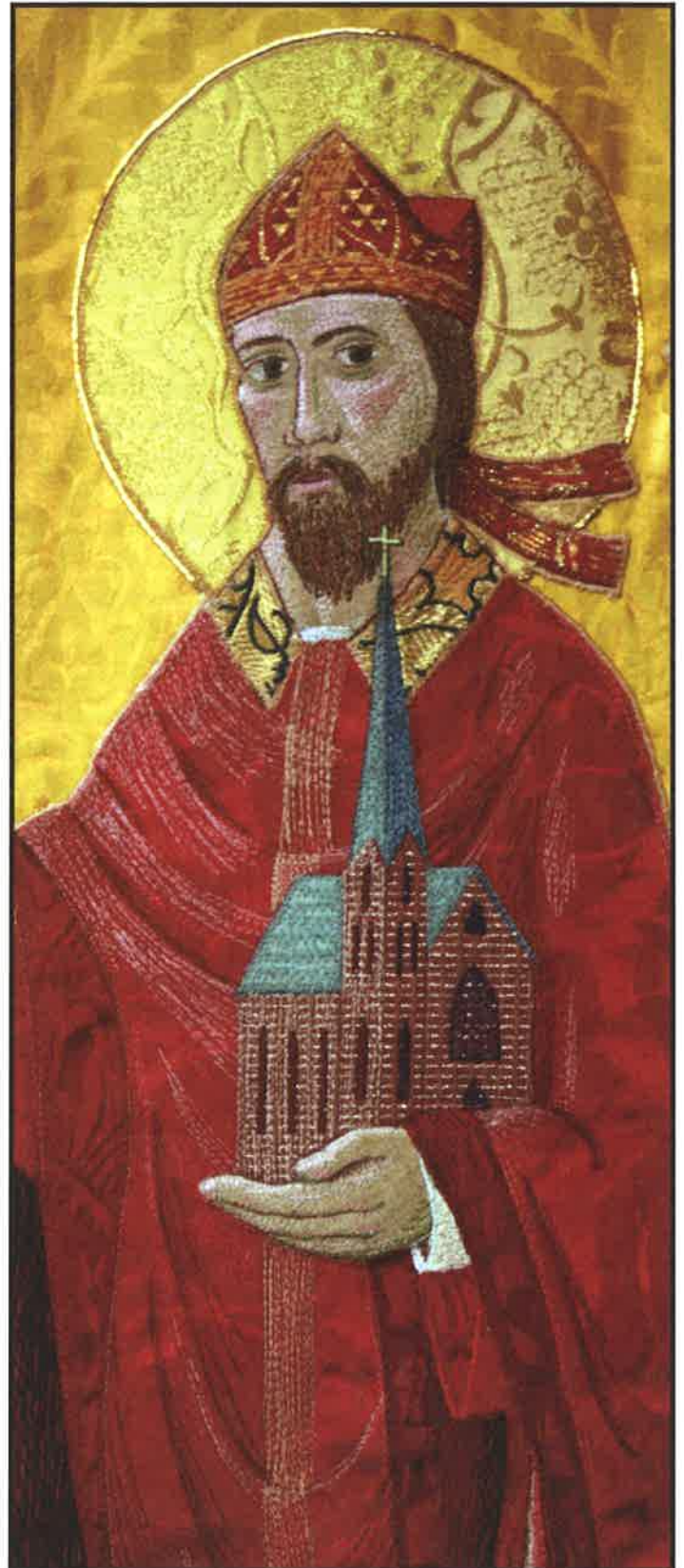

## Directory Update

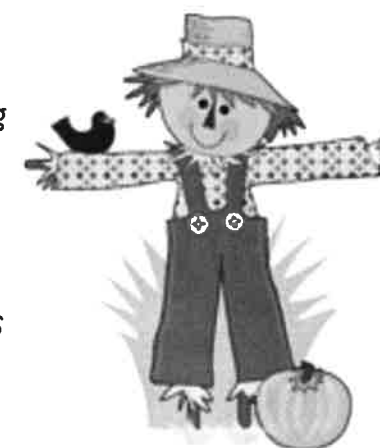
