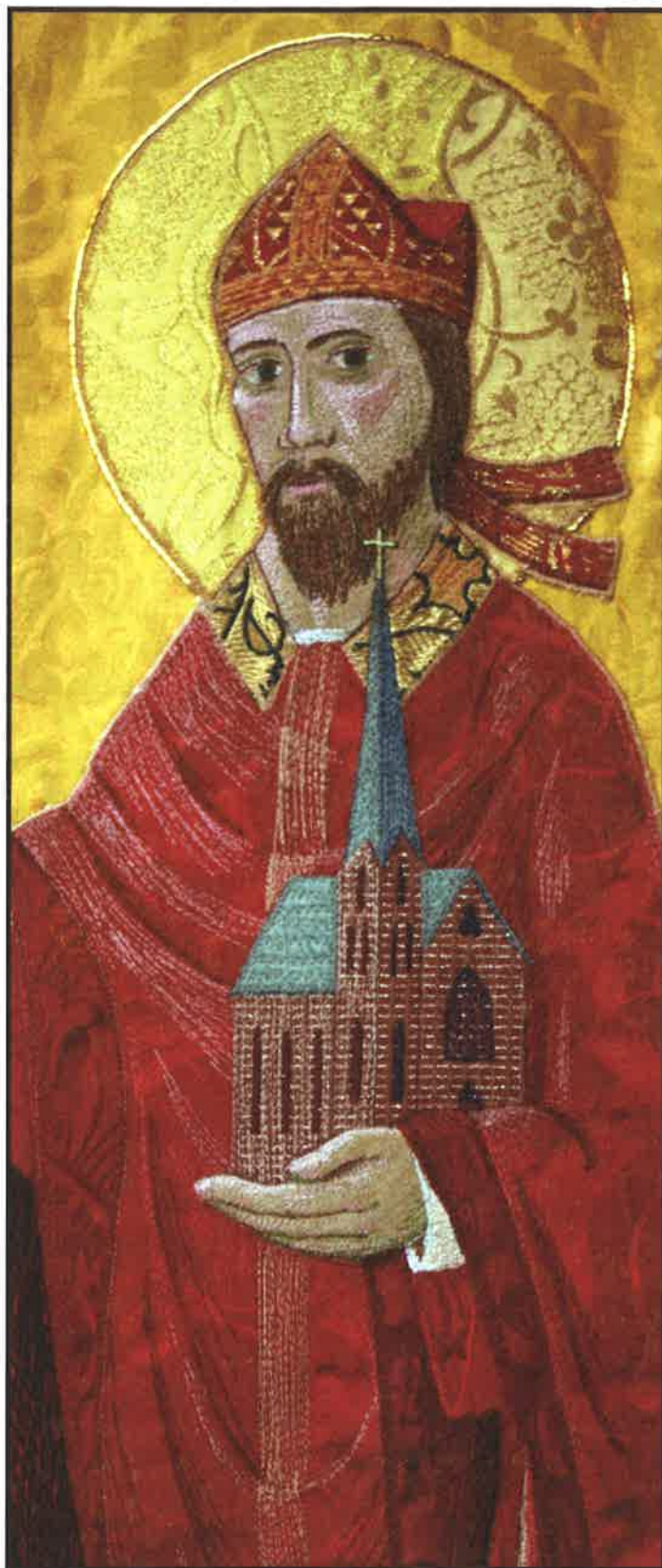

From the desk of the Parochial Vicar...

The **Feast of St. Blaise** will occur this Saturday, February 3. There is an accompanying blessing of throats with this feast. **After the Masses next weekend (February 3 and 4)**, we will mark the Feast by providing the opportunity for you to come up and be prayed over with blessed candles. This is an ancient tradition in the church and stems from the fact that St. Blaise, a martyr for the faith, apparently had a gift for healing those who had throat problems. He was said to have saved a boy who was choking on a fishbone by praying over him. The blessing that is prayed as the candles are held over your throat is: *"Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness. In the name of the Father +, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."*

Anyone is eligible to receive this blessing. There is no minimum age, and you do not have to be Catholic to receive it.

On the weekend of **February 10 and 11 during the Masses**, we will be celebrating the **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick**. Catholics eligible for the sacrament include:

- [From the Instruction on the Pastoral Care of the Sick]
- 1) A person who is seriously sick – the sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious.
 - 2) A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery.
 - 3) Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present.
 - 4) Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by the sacrament.

Furthermore, after the Masses next weekend the priest will pray over anybody else wanting prayers (e.g., for addictions, minor illnesses, strength, faith, etc.).
