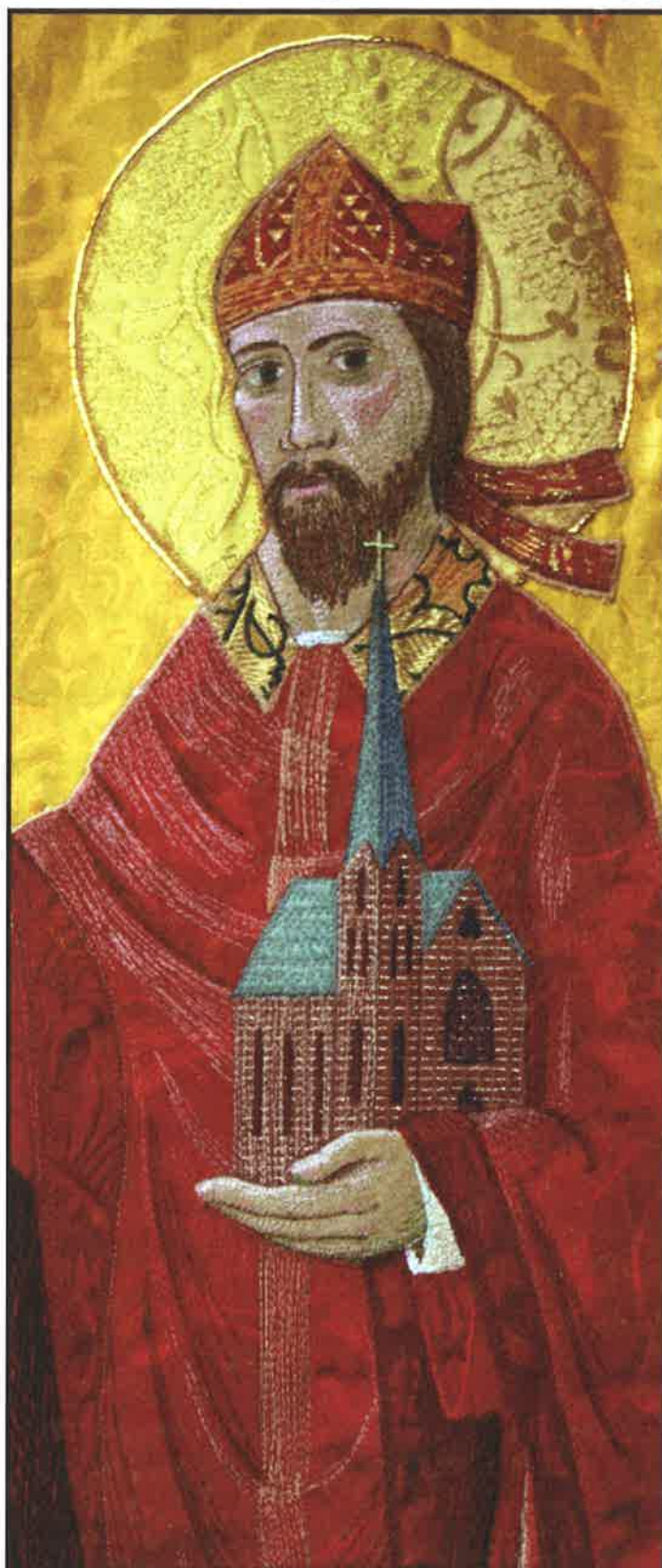

From the desk of the Parochial Vicar...

Next weekend, **February 10 and 11 during the Masses**, we will be celebrating the **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick**. Catholics eligible for the sacrament include (From the Instruction on the Pastoral Care of the Sick):

- 1) A person who is seriously sick – the sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious.
- 2) A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery.
- 3) Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present.
- 4) Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by the sacrament.

Furthermore, *after* the Masses next weekend the priest will pray over anybody else wanting prayers (e.g., for addictions, minor illnesses, strength, faith, etc.).

Please also note that as has been advertised in the bulletin, the **Catholic Women's Conference is on Saturday, February 17, and the Catholic Men's Conference is on Saturday, February 24**. These are great opportunities to reignite your faith with thousands of other women and men from the diocese. You might find some good book to lead you along your Lenten journey, or even hear that inspirational word that reinvigorates your desire for closer discipleship with the Lord.
