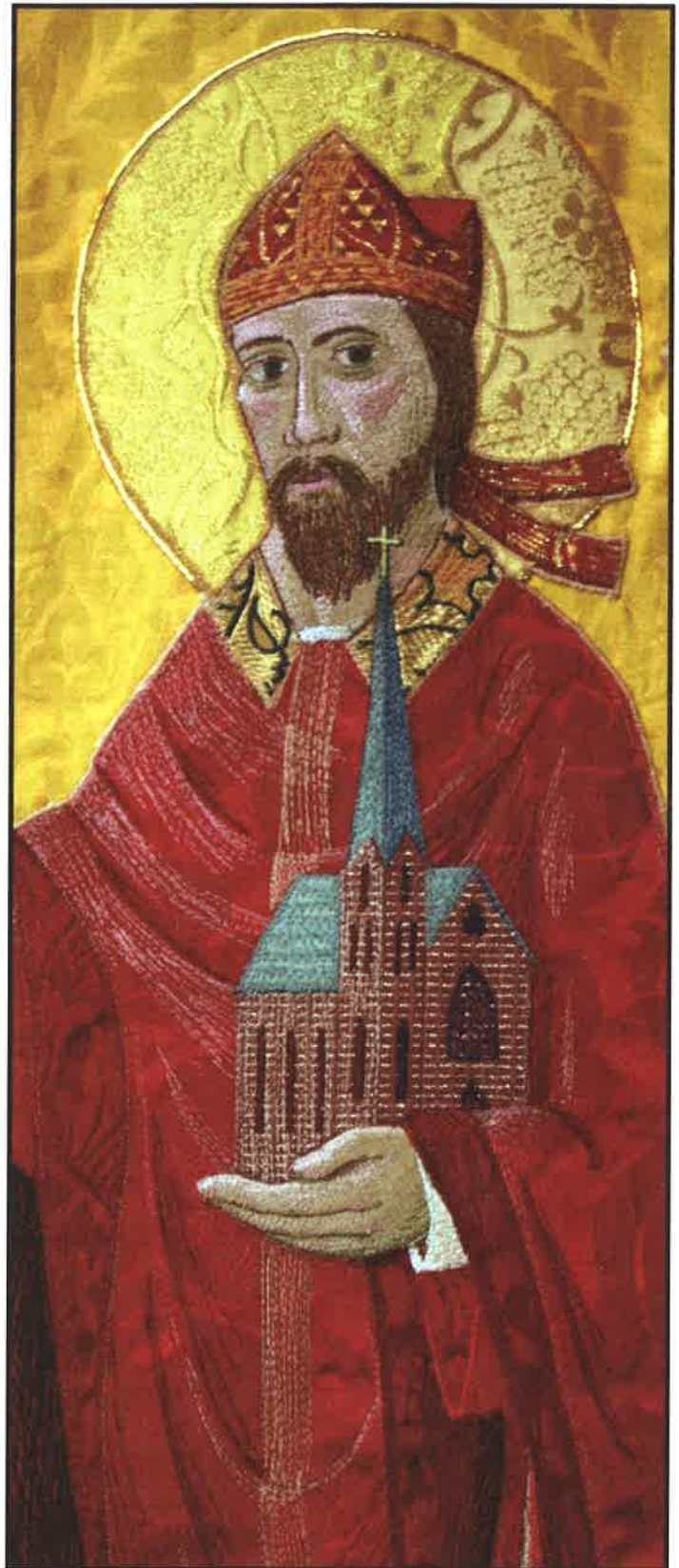

From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar...

1. Keep an eye out in your mailbox for this year's **Bishop's Annual Appeal (BAA)** mailing. As in years past we will have a parish goal over and above what the diocese sets for us. The monies that are collected over and above the parish goal come back to us to support our parish needs. More to come on what our focus project will be.

2. **Fr. David Young**, retired and in residence at Zaleski St. Sylvester, will be the celebrant for the Saturday evening Mass. I'm grateful for his help in covering as I'll be participating in the **Buck 50**. It's a 150 mile race (yes) throughout the Chillicothe area. I'm on a relay team of 10 people. The run begins Friday afternoon and ends Saturday afternoon. The proceeds support the local Chillicothe Drug Free Clubs of America chapter, M.A.D.E. (My Attitude Determines Everything). Drug addiction and opioid use are on the rise as we see in the news and as was addressed by our diocese and Bishop Campbell in his pastoral letter in Lent.

3. Finally, some news about opportunities for prayer with **Unbound**. On **Saturday, April 21, there will be an all day Unbound Conference at St. John Neumann in Sunbury**. This conference will be led by Matt Lozano and will be an excellent opportunity to learn more about this type of deliverance prayer, and have an opportunity to receive personal ministry in a prayer session. I highly recommend this if you are free that day. The cost is \$40. Register for the Unbound conference at St. John in Sunbury at heartofthefather.com on the events page. Nevertheless, for those who are unable to attend the conference at St. John Neumann we will have a simplified version here at **St. Colman on April 28**. You will have an opportunity to receive personal ministry with leaders trained in Unbound. Anyone who has read even some of the book will be well equipped to benefit from either day of prayer. Either one of these days will be an excellent culmination of our prayer and reflection during the Lenten Season. More details will follow next weekend for the April 28th schedule.
